Submission Date for all events is 31st January, 2022. List of final round participants will be uploaded on our social media pages and our website by 02nd February, 2022.

Entries without registrations will not be entertained.

The participating teams are requested to visit social media pages for regular updates. You can also join the discord server.

Schools may be disqualified for not adhering to the event rules.

Participation of a participant in multiple events is allowed, however in case of participation in overlapping events, it is the responsibility of the participant to manage the same.

PRELIMS:

All the registered participants need to fill the submission form latest by **29th January**, **2022**. The project file and the source code also needs to be provided along with the submission. If anybody fails to do so, their entry will not be considered.

The judgements will be made as per the judgement criteria published for each event and the decision of the judges will be final and binding.

FINALS:

The shortlisted participants will be asked to make a presentation of their entries. The Presentation will take place as per the schedule and google meet ID shared with you, through a WhatsApp group created for the purpose.

Round 1 (Pre-Qualifier)

Each school's team will play against another school's team. It will be a 13 round standard match held before 2 days of the main event.

Round 2 (Qualifier)

The qualified teams will be provided with a new schedule of matches. It will be a 13 round standard match held 1 day before the main event.

Round 3 (Knockouts and upper-lower brackets)

The qualified teams will be provided with a new schedule of matches. There will be 2 matches held of 13 rounds to be held on the 1st day of the event. The upper and lower bracket schedule will be decided on the performance of the teams.
