

Circular No.82/2021-22 Date: 23 Feb, 2022

Dear Parents,

Social development is an integral aspect of a child's growing up years and helps a child build strong communication skills and values that can be best acquired through peer interaction, play and class activities held at school.

The school strictly follows the covid protocols to ensure safety of all students while in school. It is desired that parents send their wards to school to familiarise the students with the physical school and bridge the learning gaps. We propose that the students of Pre School and Pre Primary attend physical school in a phased out manner w.e.f. 04 March 2022 onwards.

The following points may be kept in mind in order to prepare the students towards attending physical school:

- Easing out the anxiety of the children towards school re-opening.
- Talking about the school in a positive manner with the child.
- Not to send the wards to school if there are any signs of cold, cough or fever in the child or any family member.
- Training and preparing the students for handwashing, social distancing, masking before sending them to school.

IMPORTANT POINTS TO BE NOTED FOR THE STUDENTS ATTENDING PHYSICAL SCHOOL

The students may wear comfortable, casual dress to school during the month of March 2022.

The students will report to school at 09.30 am and will be dispersed at 11.00 am.

No buses will be plying. Pick and drop will be done by the Parents.

The students are required to carry their tiffin and water bottle in a light weight school bag. All items of the child are to be labelled properly. It is requested that an extra mask, set of clothes (specially undergarments) be also sent with the child.

IMPORTANT POINTS TO BE NOTED FOR THE STUDENTS ATTENDING ONLINE SCHOOL

The Morning Assembly will be held from 8.30 am to 9.00 am (only for the students who will not be attending school physically)

Online Academic Session will be held from 12.00 noon to 01.00 pm (only for the students who will not be attending school physically)

SCHOOL TRANSPORT (SESSION 2022-23)

It may be noted that the school is planning the transport for the next academic session. In view of this, it is desired that the parents give their transport requirements to school so that the bus routes may be designed. You may kindly refer to the Pre Primary Bus Routes through the link provided:

The prescribed school uniform (Pre Primary and Primary) will be on display on the school website by 10 March 2022.
