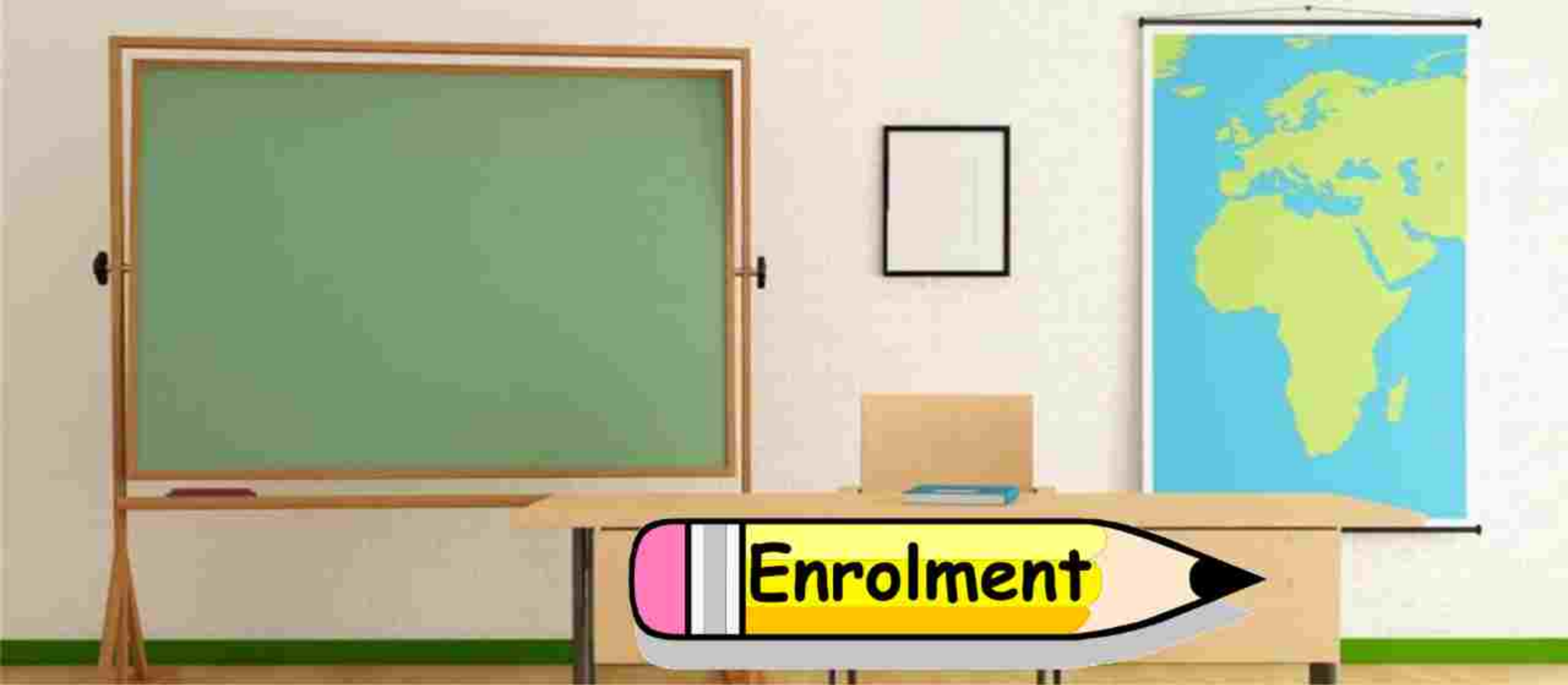

- The Online Periodic test-II for Classes VI – VIII using google forms concluded on 24 Jan, 2022.





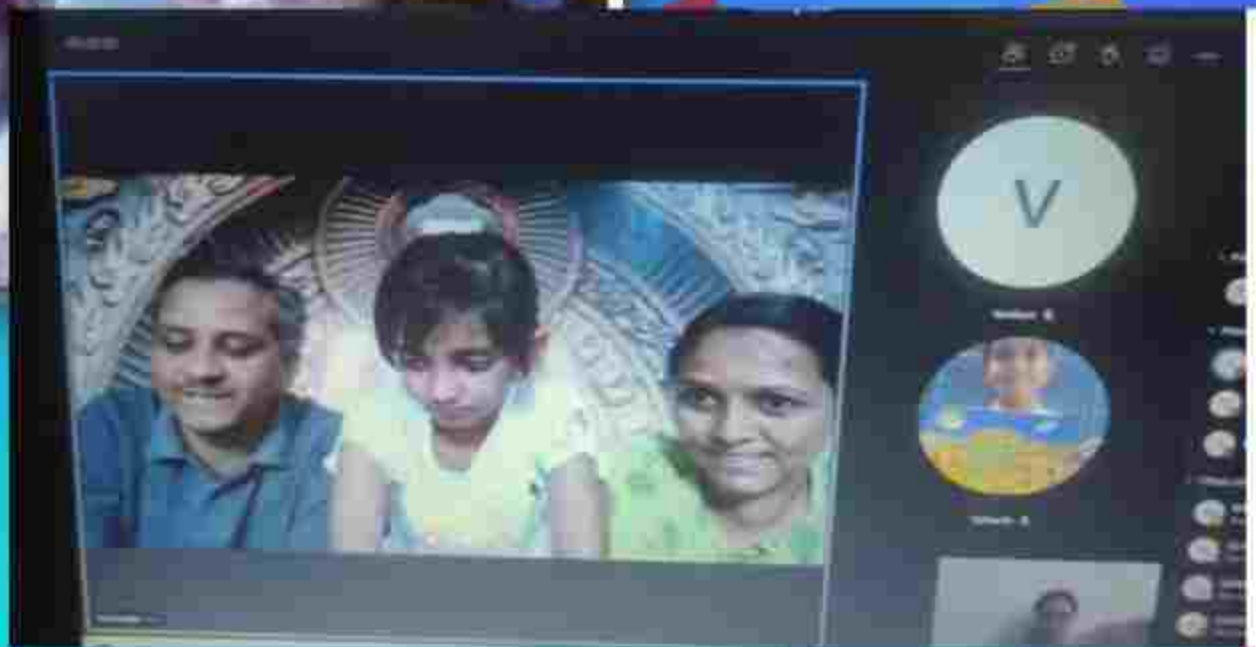
- The Post Term Examination for Class IX was held offline in pen & paper mode from 10 to 27 Dec, 2021.

The number of the students in the remedial classes has reduced considerably after Term I. Classes are taken in small groups providing the students personal attention by using innovative support material.



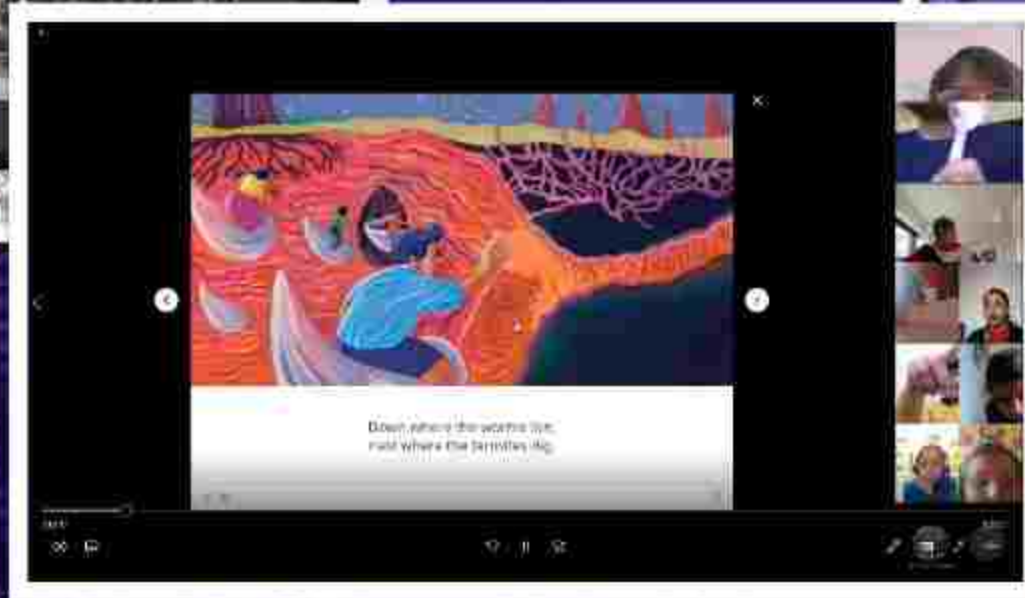
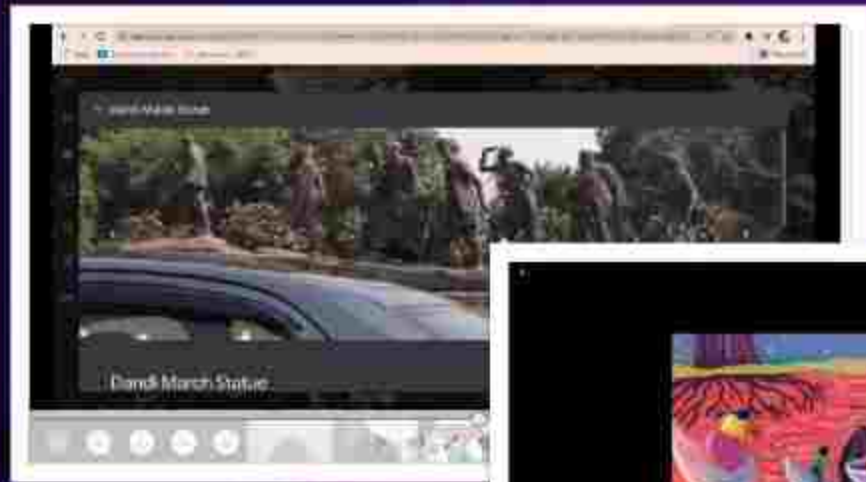
## IMPLEMENTATION OF ONLINE INNOVATIVE PEDAGOGIES

The impact of innovation in education has been huge. The inclusion of technology has redefined education in more ways than imaginable. Teachers have been trained to use various innovative teaching methods to make lessons more meaningful and interesting.





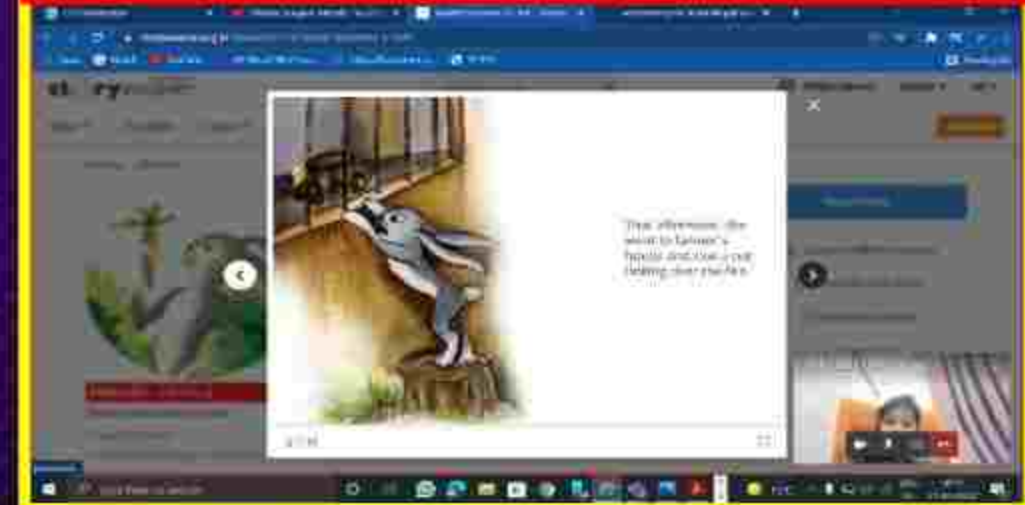
- Experiment-based learning, Creation of a Class Digital Scrapbook in order to inculcate a sense of exploration in the learners, Quizziz, Live worksheets, Spin the wheel, Storyweaver, Puppetry, Extramarks modules, Fact sharing sessions, Science songs have been made a part of Online Teaching Learning process.



- Bhasha Sangam Integrated approach towards various languages and cultures has been well adopted by the school.
- Story Weaver, an app promoted by CBSE Reading Mission, has been incorporated into the syllabus for assessment of reading and speaking skills. Students have started creating books using storyweaver and book creator Apps. They have also learnt to create their own newspaper using Boomwriter, Nearpod and Pixton applications. Padlet has been used for collaborative discussion and View sharing in the classroom.




- Read aloud books have been introduced in syllabus and parents of Pre Primary and Primary wing are enrolled with storyweaver app. Wordle and Shabdle, the latest vocabulary building games have been introduced to engage students enthusiastically in word building.
- 21 staff members have developed the audio and video content to participate in AICEF (All India Children's Educational Audio-Video Festivals.) organized by CBSE.



- To make the students aware of the pitfalls of the virtual world and create awareness about the Cyber Space, the Computer Dept shares a 'Cyber Safety Tip' of the day with the students, staff and parents.

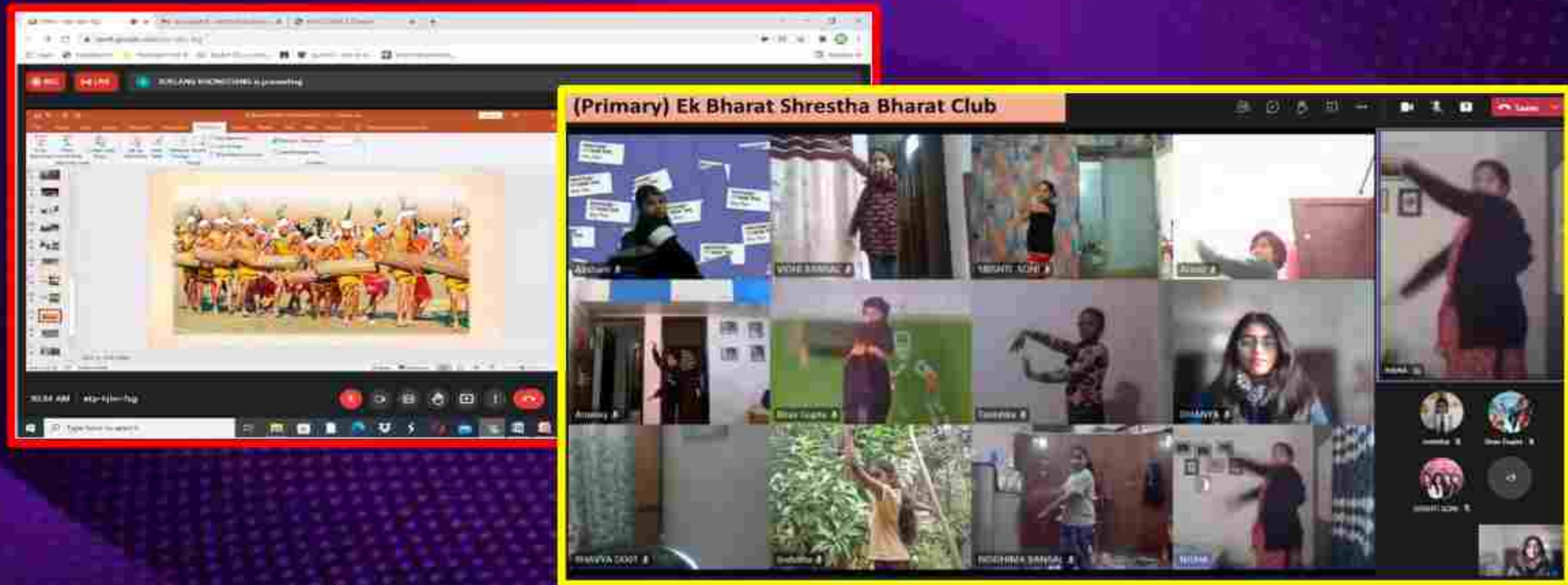

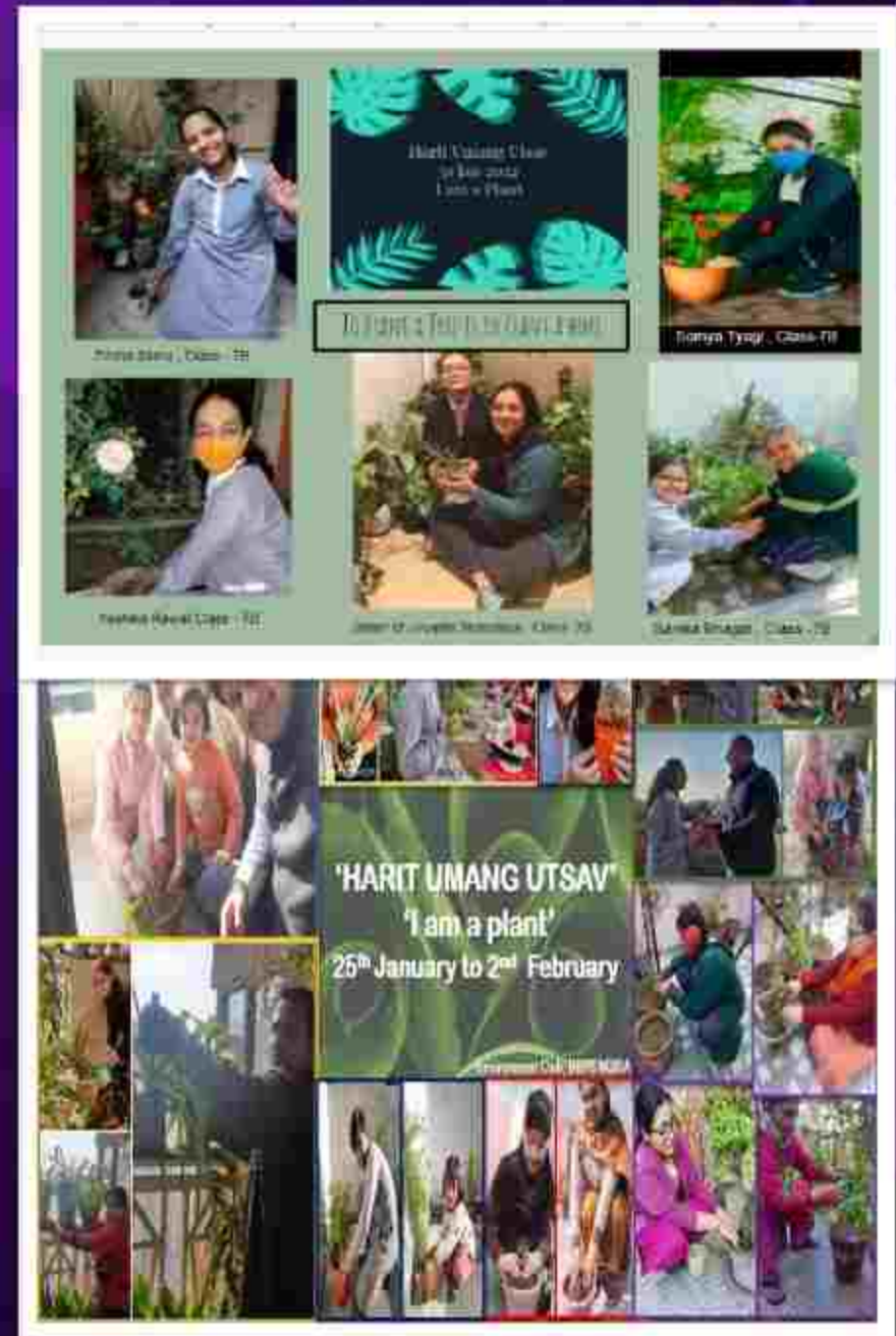

- Online sessions were regularly conducted by the Special Educators for the holistic development of children with Special Needs. The sessions are supplemented with customized worksheets and academic resources available on NCERT and Diksha Portal in order to maximize the learning outcomes.

### FACILITATOR'S FEEDBACK OF VIDEO CONFERENCE

Personal experiences about rights and inequalities were shared by students. They gave good examples from their lives about how pandemic had affected their rights. There was discussion on how can they as students empower their rights. They moved on speaking about some rights that may be misused, they gave some examples. A question regarding discrimination let a student open up her heart to share a powerful experience from her life. Students showed a high level of empathy which empowered the students and enriched the dialogue. Students articulated themselves well and confidently. They built a dialogue thread by answering each other and the conversation moved on smoothly. In this video conference students were able to critically think, they used words like I agree or I disagree.

Learning Outcome:

Students shared their personal experiences about rights and inequalities and discussed how the pandemic had changed their lives. Students honed their listening skills and soft skills, as sensitive issues like income parity, treatment of women, favouritism based on marks, looks, etc were taken up boldly by students. They not only understood the targets set under SDG 4 & 5, but also explored various problems and their potential solutions to achieve quality education for all and equality in society. Indeed every student took away something meaningful from this interaction and was able to enrich his/her understanding of dynamics of cultures and societies across the world.

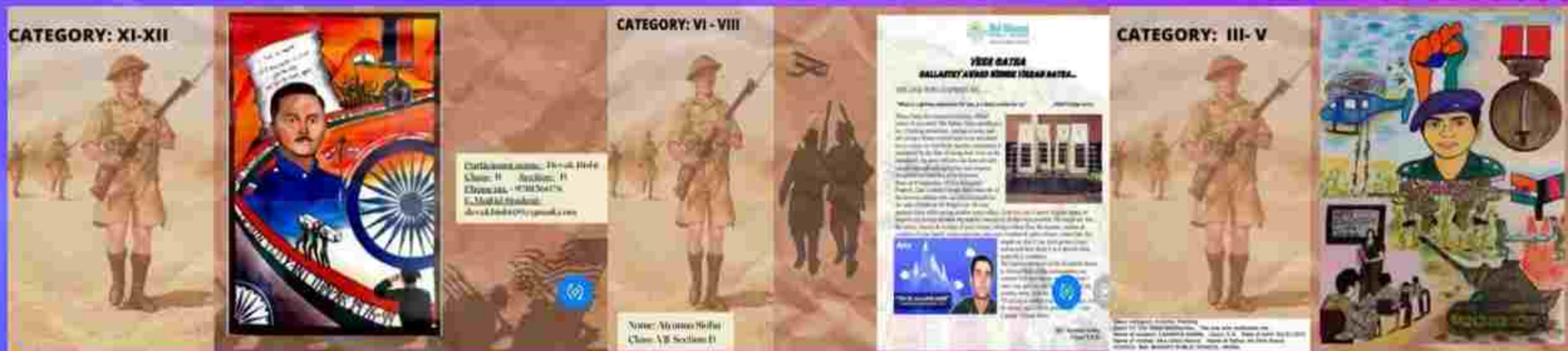






## VEER GATHA PROJECT: 21 OCTOBER 2021- 20 NOVEMBER 2021

## CBSE HERITAGE INDIA QUIZ (28.01.2022 TO 28.02.2022)



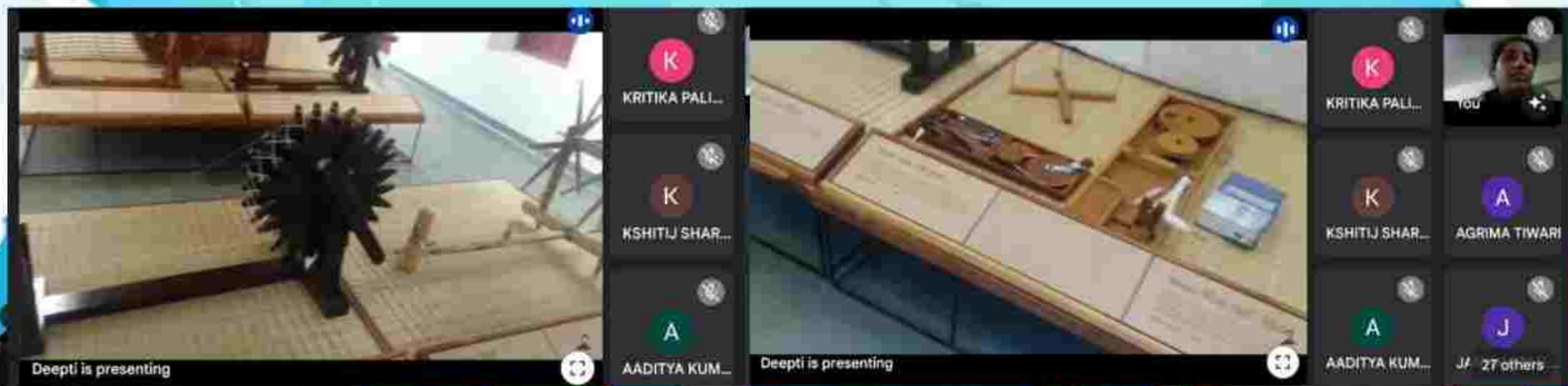

Parts of the vehicles are removed, its frame is lifted and a square shaped recycled block is produced.



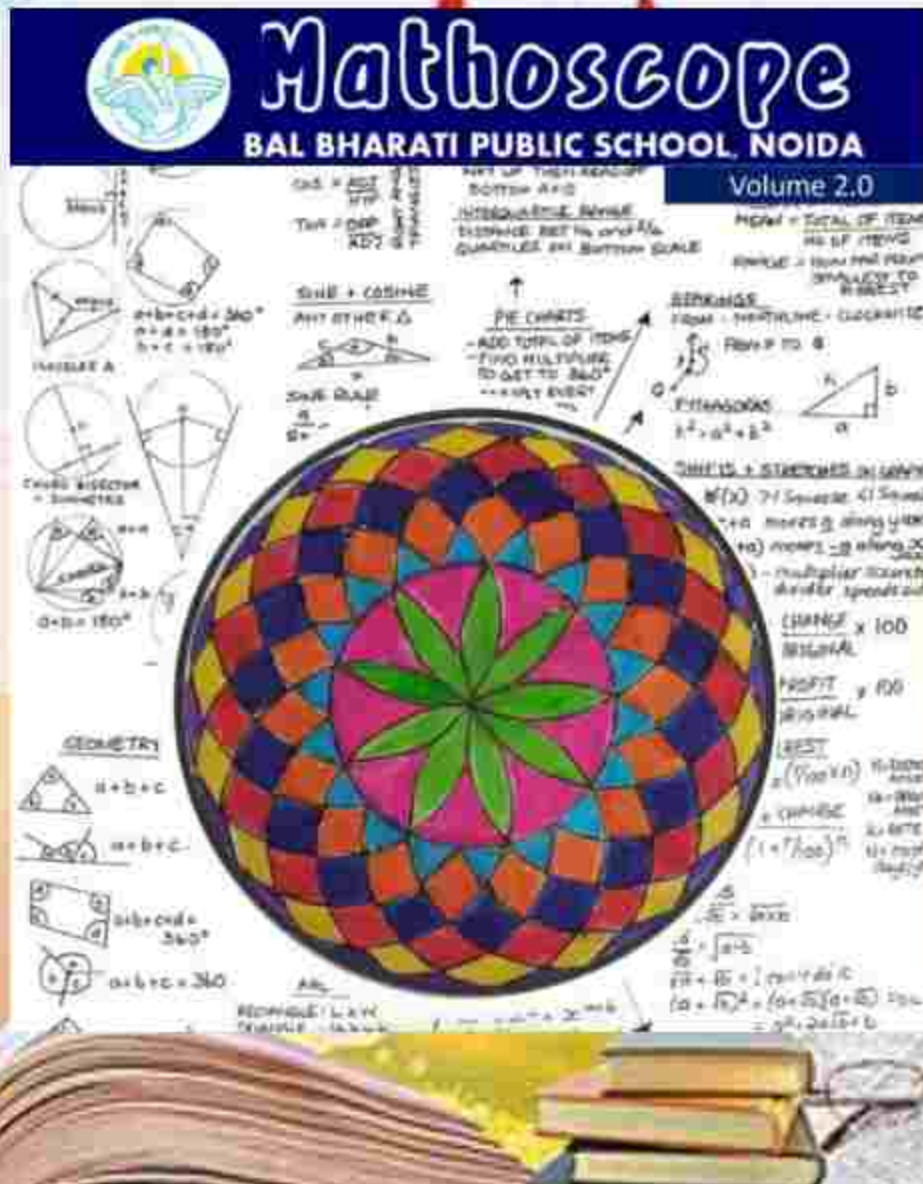



The Graphic Novels are nearing completion and the school is in the process of applying for the QR Codes with CBSE.

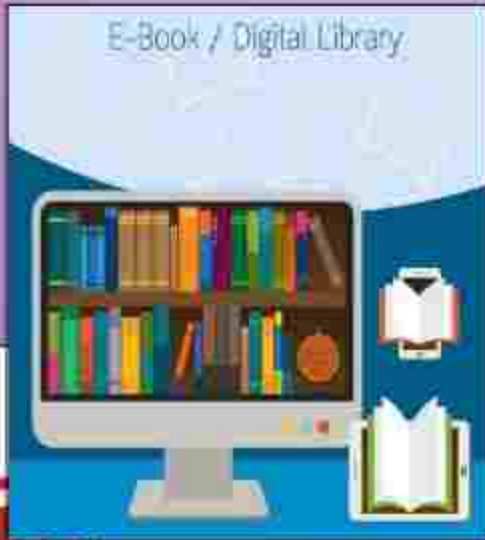


## ANY OTHER INTRODUCTION OF CODING AS A SKILL SUBJECT

The joining of outsourced Safai Karamcharis from the agency has been put on hold, but the regular safai karamcharis of the school have started reporting to the school on a daily basis.

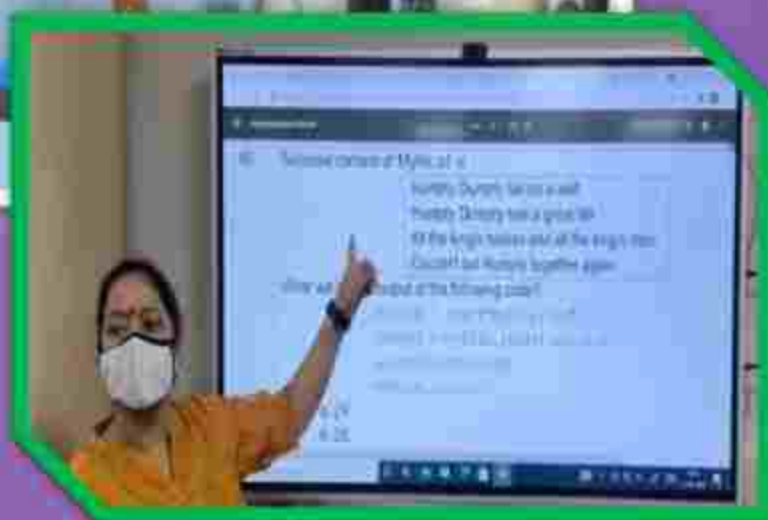
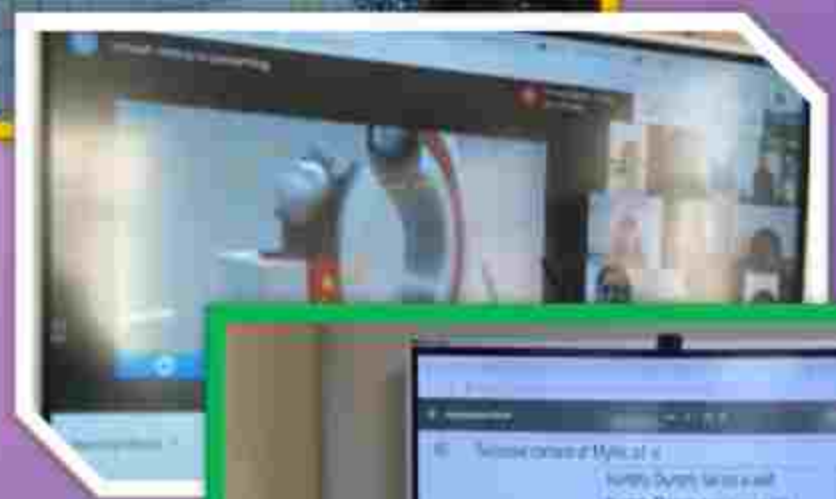
## Labs

# DIGITIZATION

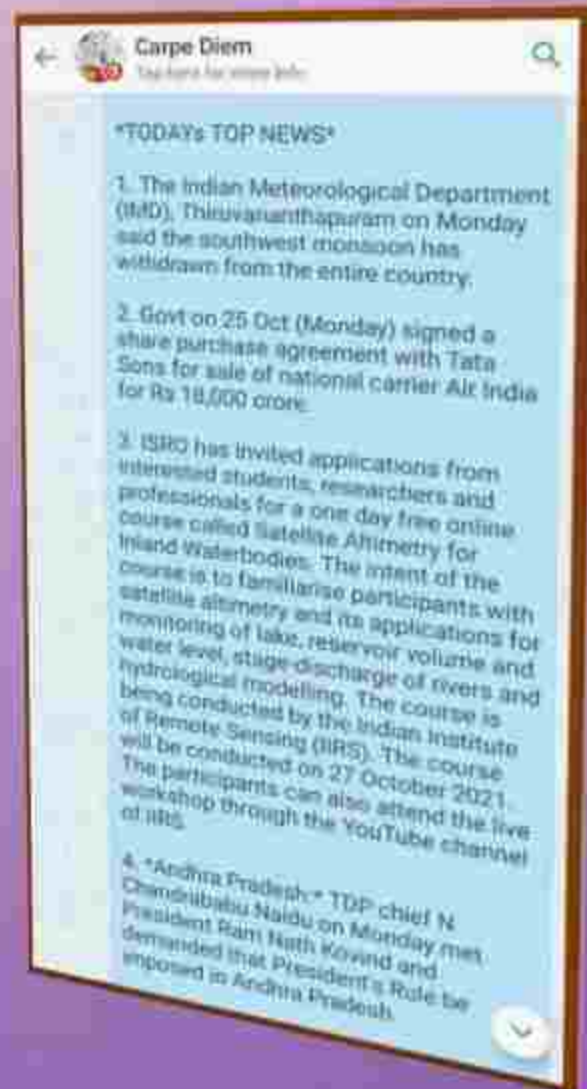

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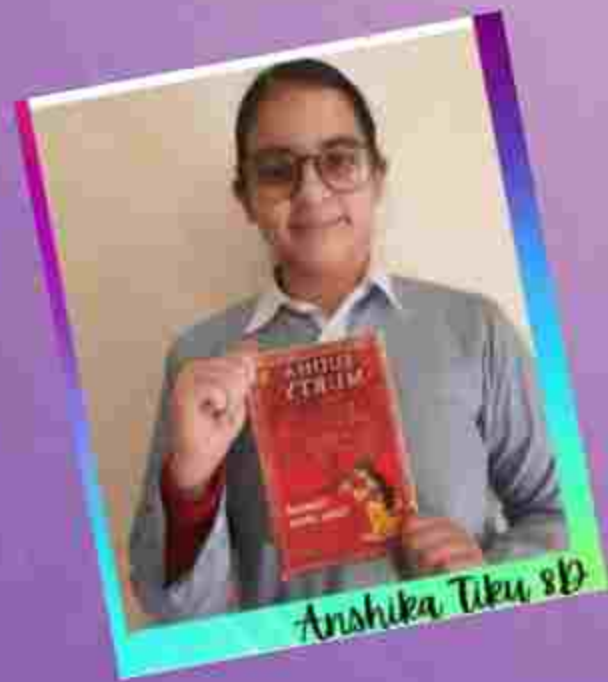

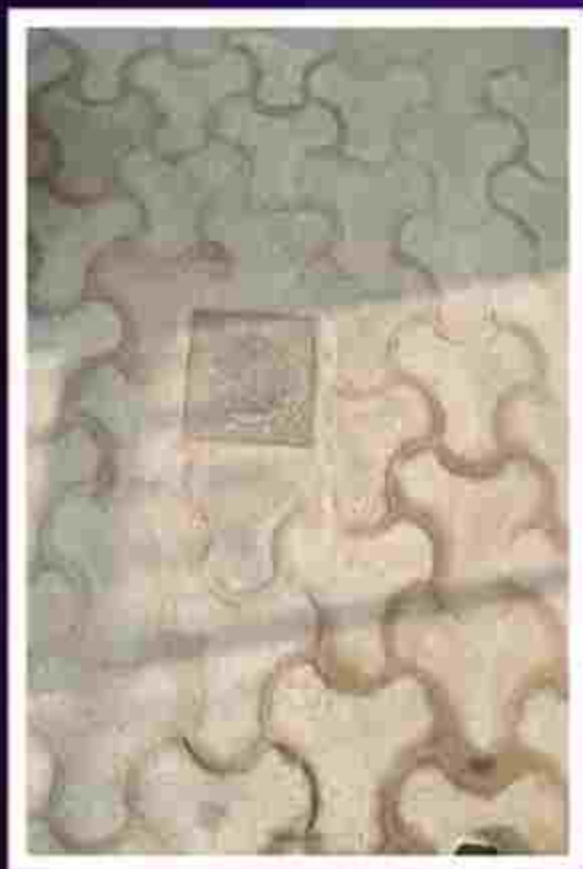
