*All the activities and the use of internet for doing the activities to be done strictly under the supervision of parents.


*Practice sheets of English, Hindi and Maths will be uploaded on teams channel. Work to be done in notebook and brought as per the schedule.

- Decoration of the Diary/Dictionary has to be as per the theme 'Life Under Water'.





MATHEMATICS INTEGRATED WITH ICT






Dear students,

As we have learned about 2D and 3D shapes, let's wear our creative hat and imagine the "Life below Water" in those shapes.






ASSIGNMENT
