## **RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

- Two participants from each House (one from each class) will participate
- A dramatic monologue from one of William Shakespeare's Tragic, Historic, Romantic plays like King Lear, Macbeth, Othello, Hamlet, Merchant of Venice, Much Ado About Nothing or any other plays may be chosen by the participants
- Introduction of the playwright and the scene to be presented in one minute by one of the participants
- Character of the protagonist or the antagonist to be described in one minute, by the first participant
- The monologue, presented by the second participant, should not exceed three minutes
- Use of appropriate props and costume is mandatory
- Reference to paper will lead to disqualification
- Participants must provide the hard copy of the content to the judges for reference
- Time duration: 5 Minutes

## **CRITERIA FOR JUDGEMENT:**

- Clarity of Speech / Voice modulation
- Appropriate selection of monologue
- Dialogue Delivery/ character portrayal
- Use of props and relevance of costumes
- Pronunciation and Presentation
