Dear Parent,

The Central University Entrance Test (CUET) is an all-India level entrance exam introduced in year 2022 to be conducted by National Testing Agency for admission to UG courses offered in all colleges under Delhi University. Also, this Common University Entrance Test (CUET) will be held for admission to undergraduate programmes in any of the 45 UGC-funded central universities in India. To be eligible for CUET, the candidate must have passed 10+2 CBSE/ICSE/ State Board Exam.

As per the latest CUET-2022 updates, the CUET entrance test will have four sections:

- Section IA 13 Languages
 - Section IB 19 Languages
 - Section II 27 Domain-Specific Subjects
 - Section III General Test

CANDIDATES CAN OPT FOR COMBINATION OF AT THE MOST 2 LANGUAGES AND 6 DOMAIN-SPECIFIC SUBJECT OR 3 LANGUAGES AND 5 DOMAIN-SPECIFIC TESTS.

- Section 1 A and 1 B will include Reading Comprehension based on different types of passages.
- Literary Aptitude and Vocabulary.
- Grammar
- Verbal Ability
