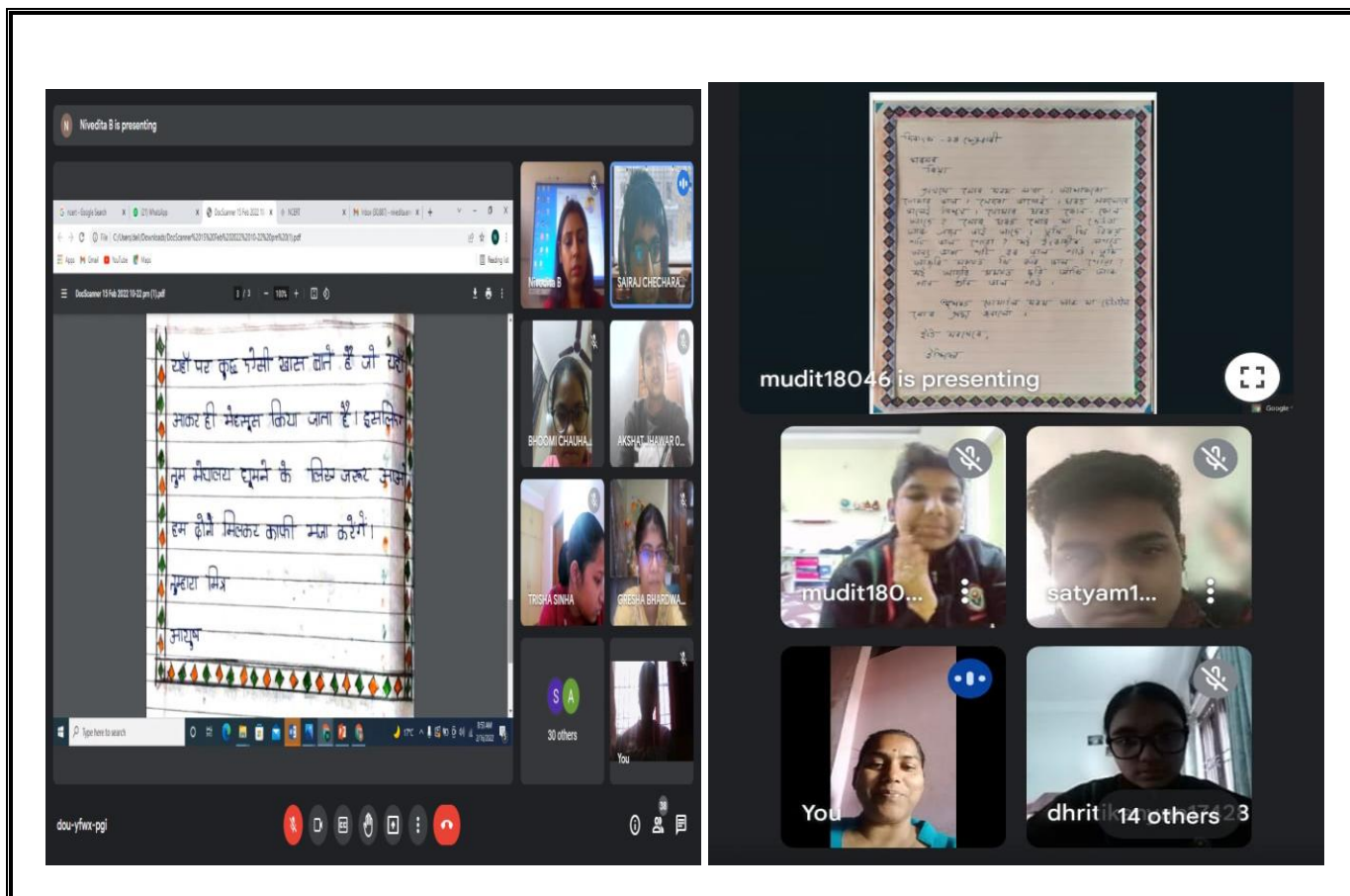

Arunachal Pradesh's diverse terrain, climate, and soils are reflected in its fauna and flora.



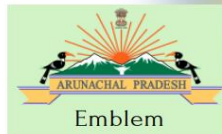
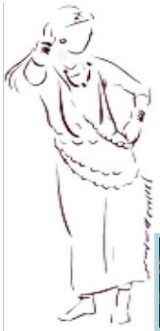
Arunachal Pradesh has the lowest population density in India.
