Dear Staff,

Please note copying, downloading and using unlicensed software is an act of copyright infringement and is subject to civil and criminal penalties.

Criminal copyright infringement is a felony and can be punished by five years in prison.

Under the Indian Copyright Act, a software pirate can be tried under both Civil and Criminal law. The minimum jail term for software copyright infringement is seven days, and the maximum jail term is three years. Statutory fines range from a minimum of 50,000 to a maximum of 200,000 rupees.

All Staff members are strictly advised not to use any unlicensed version of software on school owned machines or while using g-suite ids/Microsoft Platform.

This is a statute compliance and staff is required to adhere to this compliance. The school will not be responsible for any of the consequences in case of non compliance met by any of the staff members.
