




















To familiarize students with all the 22 Indian languages of the 8th schedule of the Indian Constitution

Short dialogues consisting of 100 simple commonly used sentences have been designed in the 22 languages for use by students of all classes.




The letters of alphabet of each language and simple proverbs and sayings will also be added in the language spoken.





The suggested activities should be carried out in a joyful and interesting manner for the students to enjoy and participate.





- A planner to be prepared in advance as per the assembly schedule and the language assigned. The same must be approved a week prior to the assembly.






