

The carry home message of the webinar was "Vaccination is the most effective way to remain safe from Covid and it is important that all eligible students get vaccinated at the earliest."

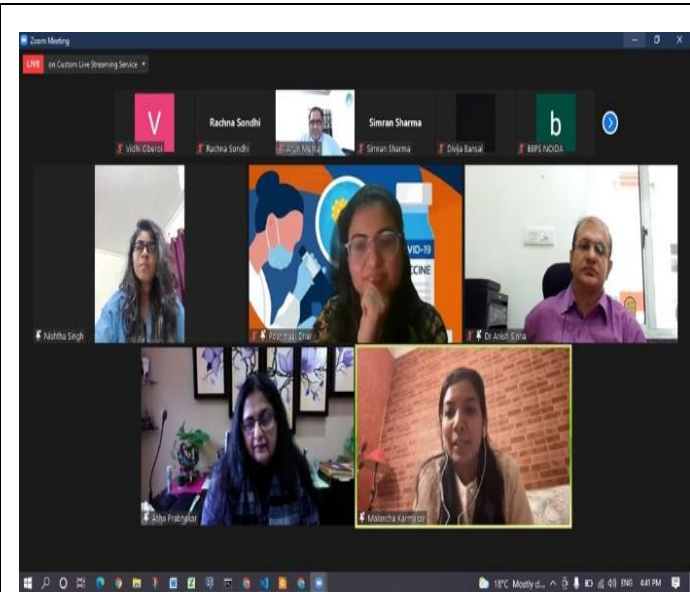
POSHMAAL DHAR , NISHTHA JAIN

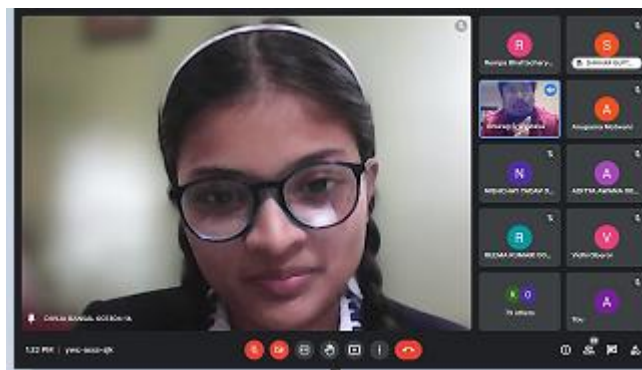

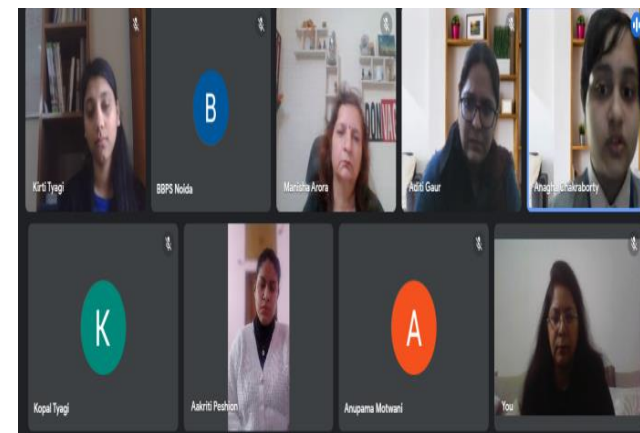

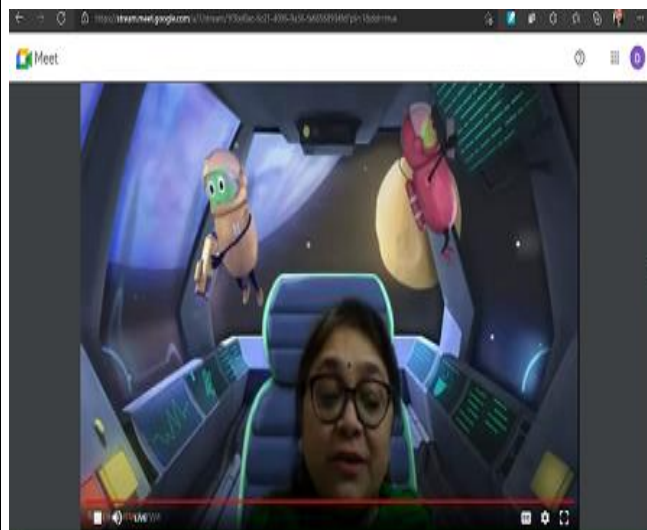
SHORYA KAPOOR
