An anchor chart is a teaching-learning tool that helps visually capture important information from the lesson. They are created, at least in part, to help emphasize and reiterate important information, procedures, processes, or skills being taught.

- * Each team has to select one topic from class XI or XII Chemistry syllabus.
- * Each team has to explain the topic using Anchor Chart prepared by them.
- * All information about the topic and basic outlines can be drawn in advance but final drawing will be done at the venue only for which 40 minutes will be given.
- * A2 sheet will be provided at the time of competition. Students are to carry their colour box.
- * The maximum time allowed for presentation per team is 5 to 7 minutes.
- * The decision of the judges will be final and binding
