This fun activity was conducted in the class introducing the form of puppetry which involves manipulation of inanimate objects for the students of Pre school and Pre Primary. Puppet play is a great way to promote role play and teach social skills. The activity was initiated with the discussion about the concept of camouflage and its significance for an animal's survival. The students were explained natural phenomenon used by plants and animals to blend into their environment.



The children started the activity by making stick puppet of a Panda after the demosration given by the respective class teachers. The teachers provided different materials like origami sheets, crayons, googly eyes, ice cream sticks, etc to the students. The children were encouraged to use their creativity and imagination in designing their stick puppet aesthetically.
