Each state of India has a unique style of this art like in Uttar Pradesh it is known as Chauk Purna, in West Bengal it is known as Alpana, in Tamil Nadu it is known as Kolam and in Rajasthan it is known as Mandana.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- * Two participants from each house (one student from each class)
- * Art of rangoli should be of 2 ft x 2 ft and must be chosen from any one of the states i.e., Uttar Pradesh, West Bengal, Tamil Nadu and Rajasthan.
- * Maximum time to complete the rangoli is 1 hr.
- * Each team is responsible for arrangement of the materials required to prepare the rangoli.
- * Participants will present the art of rangoli explaining the style and design in 1-2 min. to the judge.
- * The judge's decision will be final and binding.

- * Overall appearance and appeal
- * Details and clarity in the design
- * Authenticity
- * Creativity
