- Audiobooks developed by NCERT are also used to enhance learning outcomes amongst CWSN.



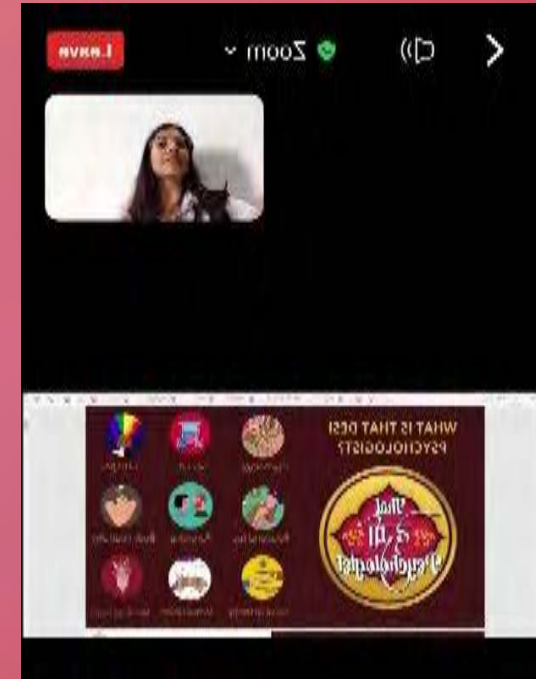


ALUMNI CONNECT – KEY TO INSTITUTIONAL GROWTH

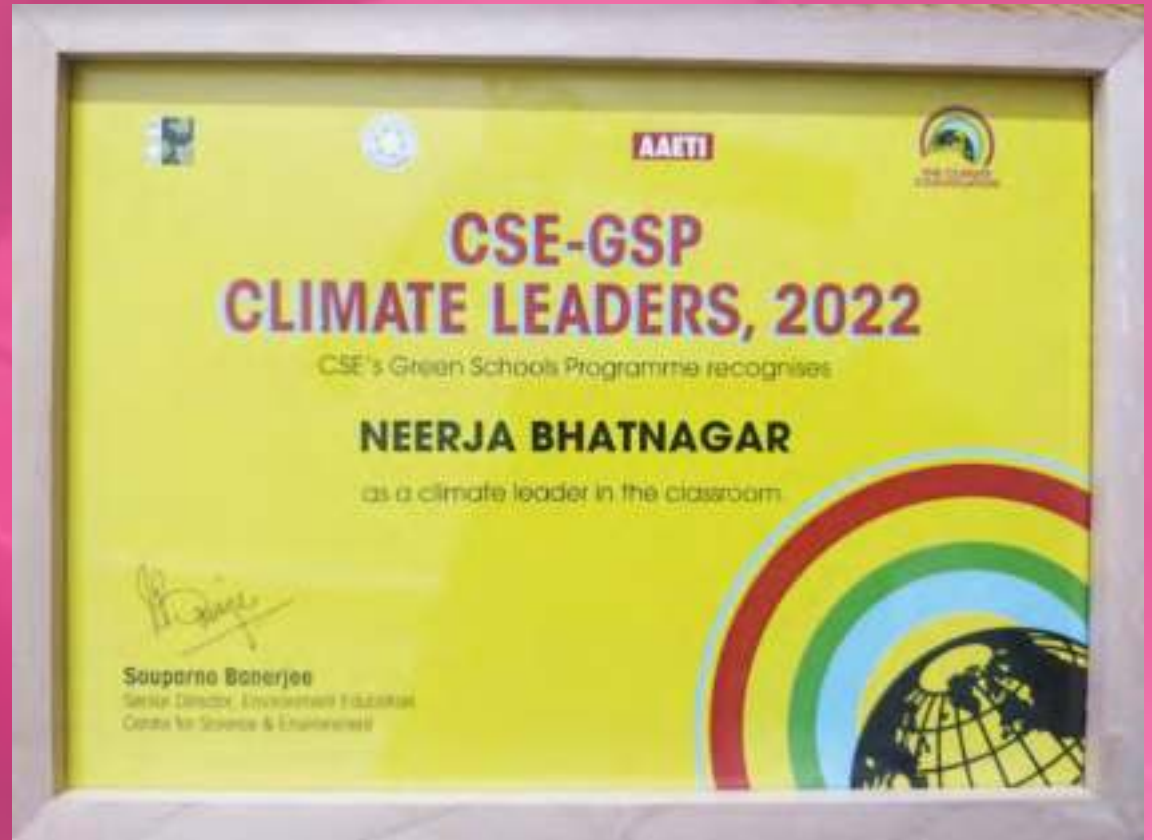

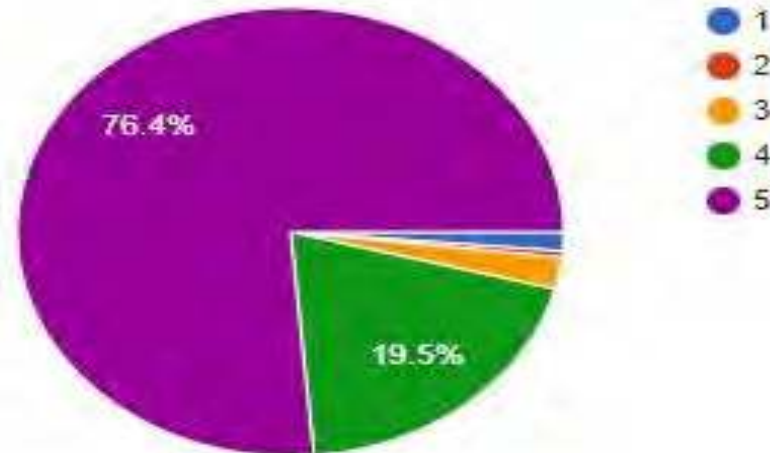

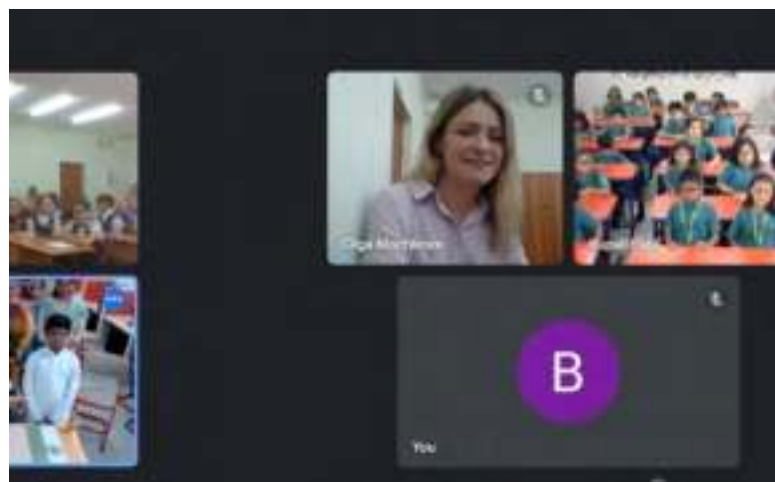

These questions led to multiple responses and students were critically thinking and sharing personal experiences. Anshika Tikur (IX) participated in the dialogue actively, she reflected that she learnt that it was okay to have difference of opinion, she needed to be respectful in the way she expressed and she would surely work upon how to take someone's judgement in a constructive manner. She also commented that the dialogue session was informative, it improved her vocabulary and allowed her to gain confidence.

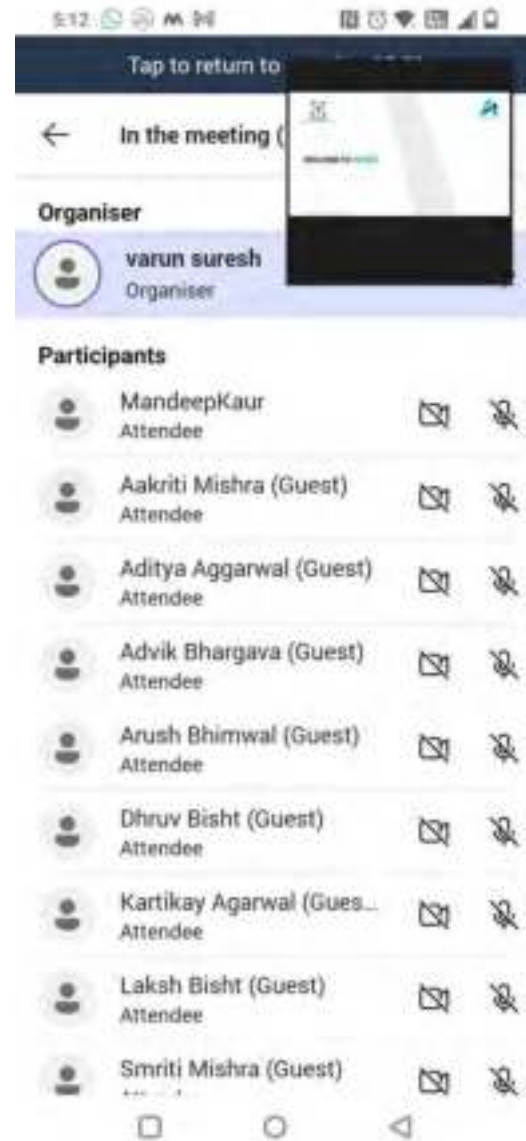
BBPS, Noida along with K12 Activity Academy formed an iShark Tank Club to promote entrepreneurship amongst students in the month of Sep, 2022.

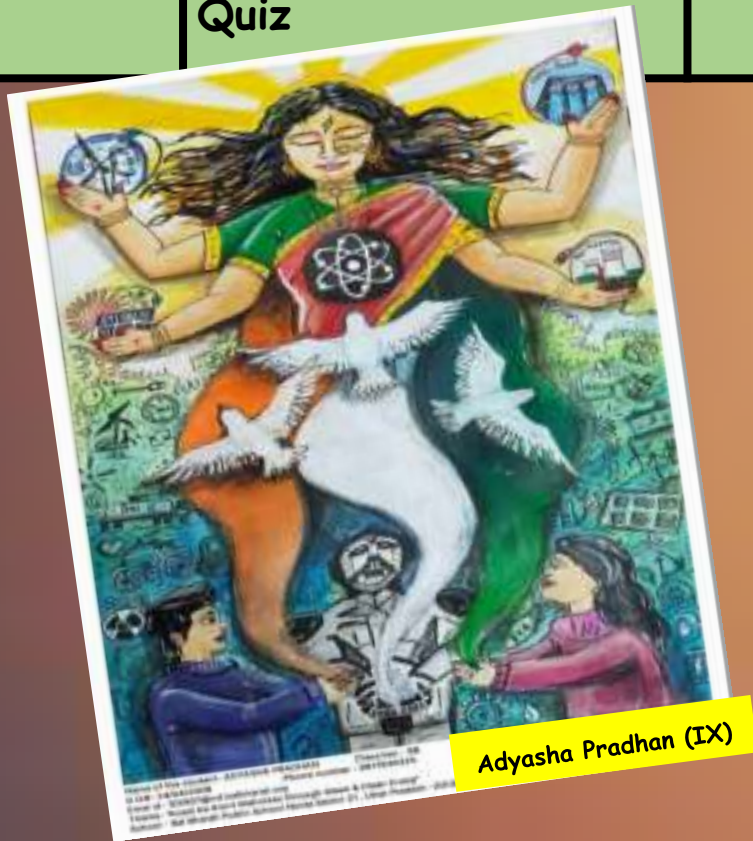

The YouTube live telecast links of different episodes were shared with our parent fraternity, all schools across Delhi/NCR, sister units pan India and our international partners.

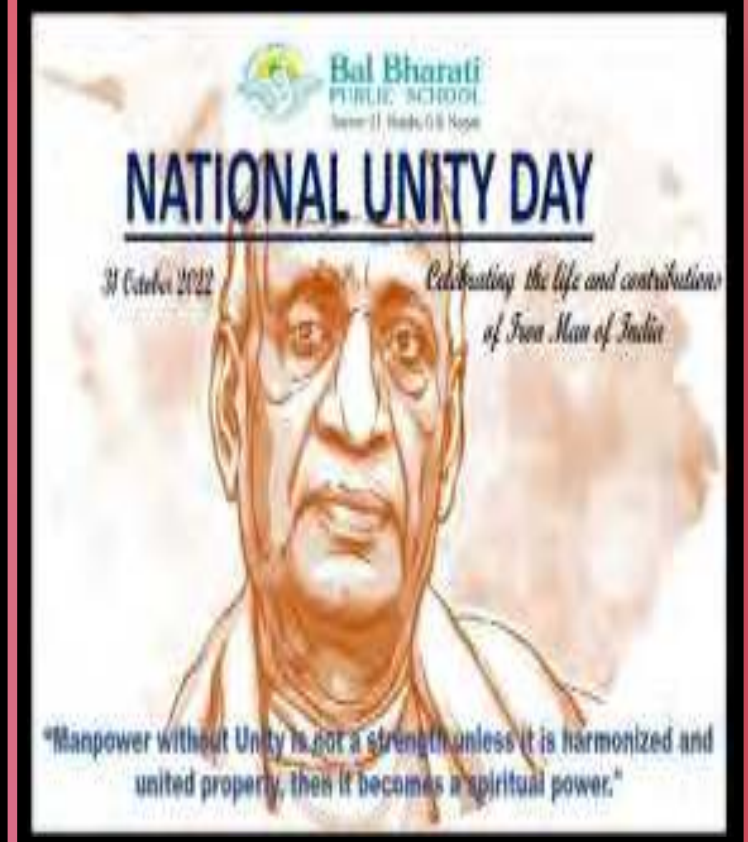

CBSE Reading Mission

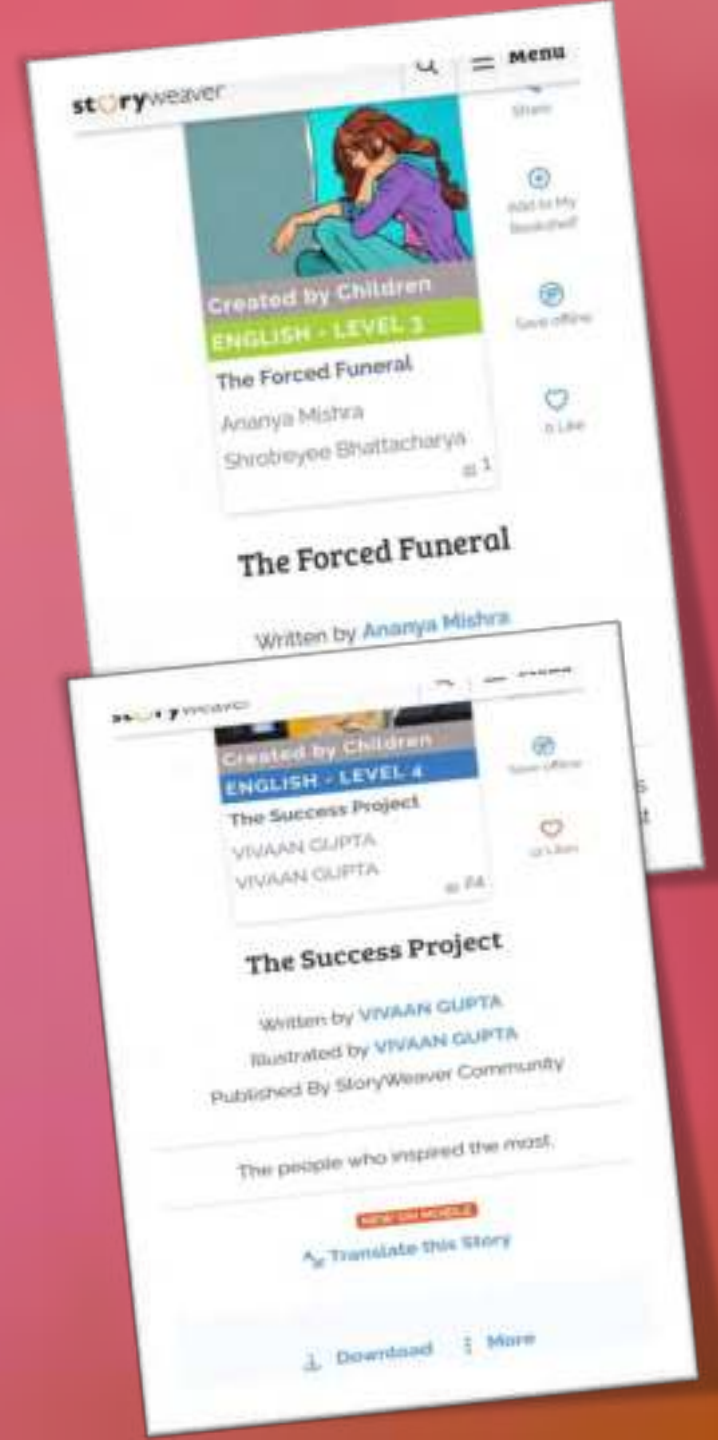

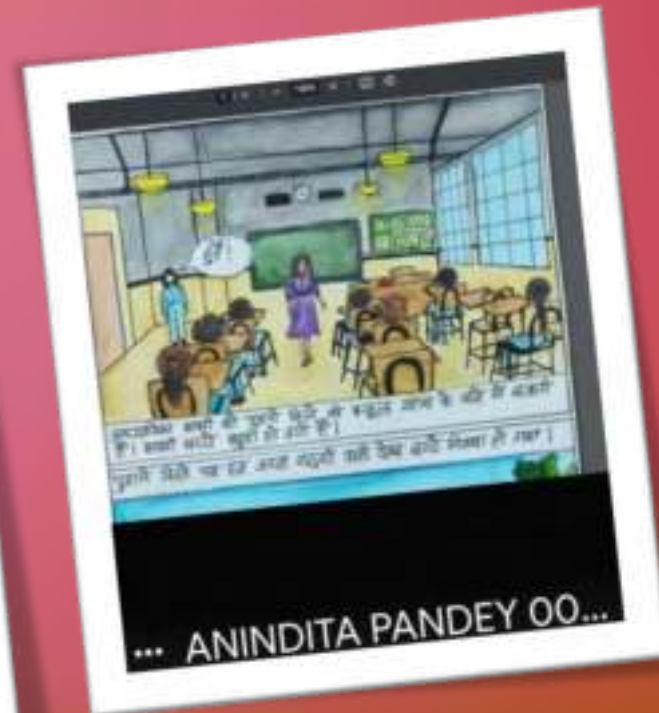
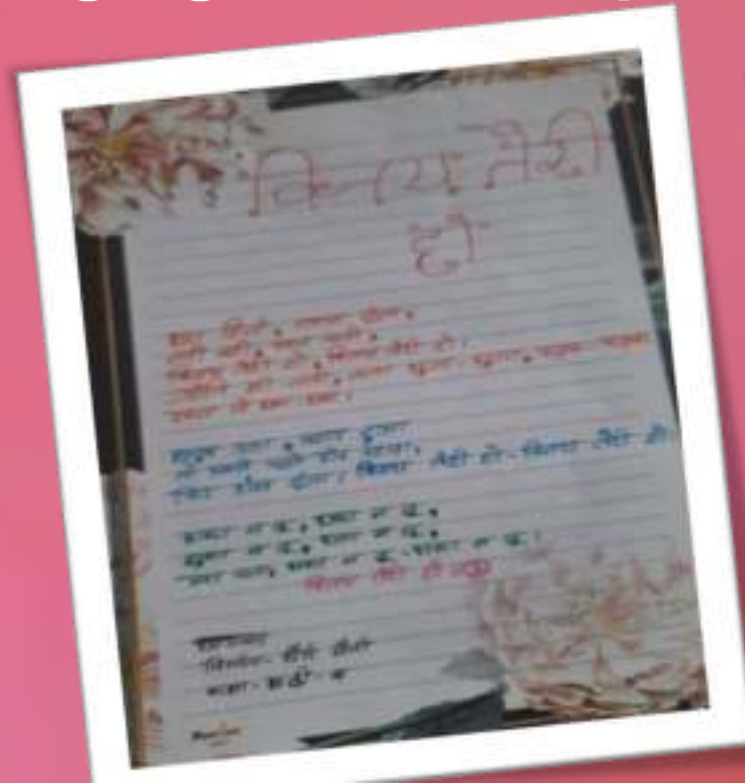
CBSE Budding Authors

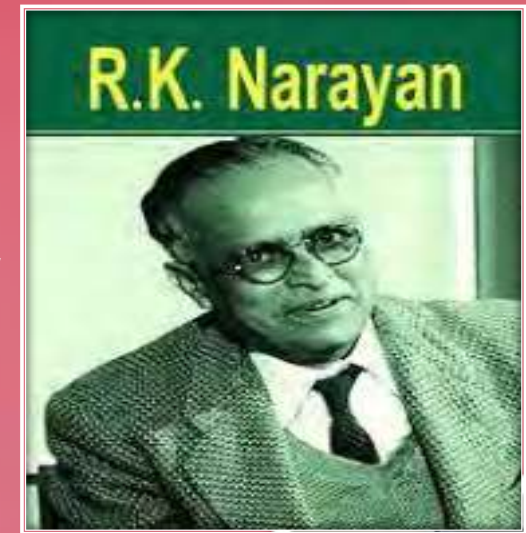
TGIF

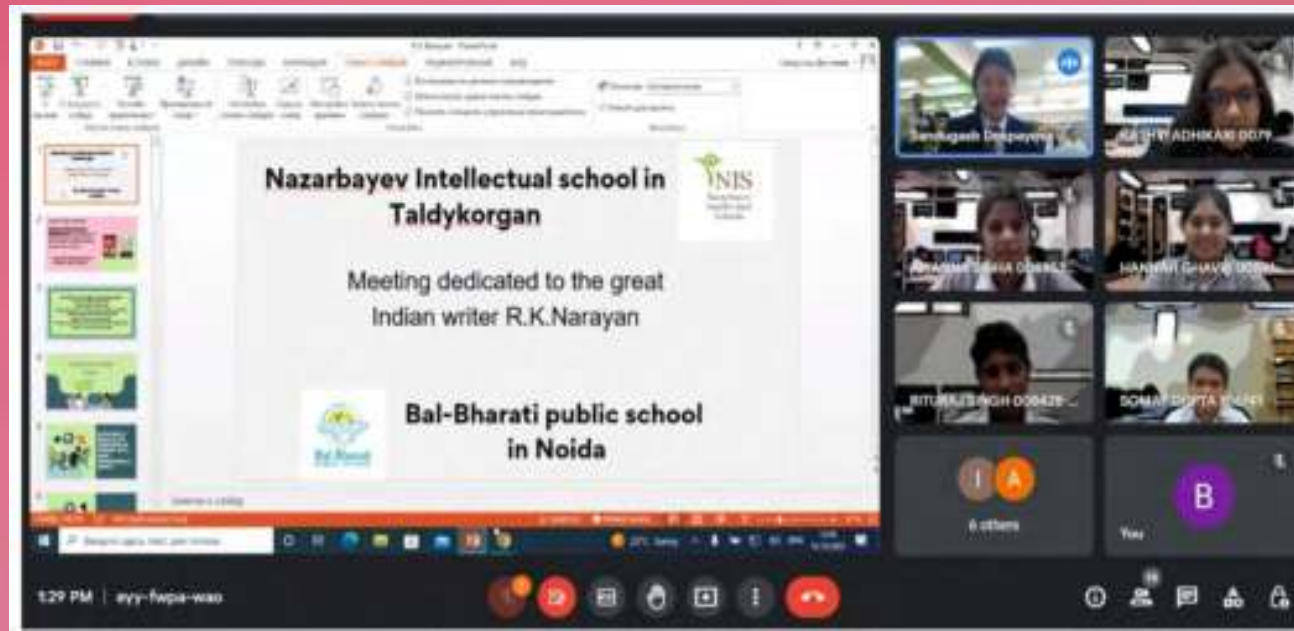
Celebration of R K Narayan Week

School Transport
