# Best School Library Award

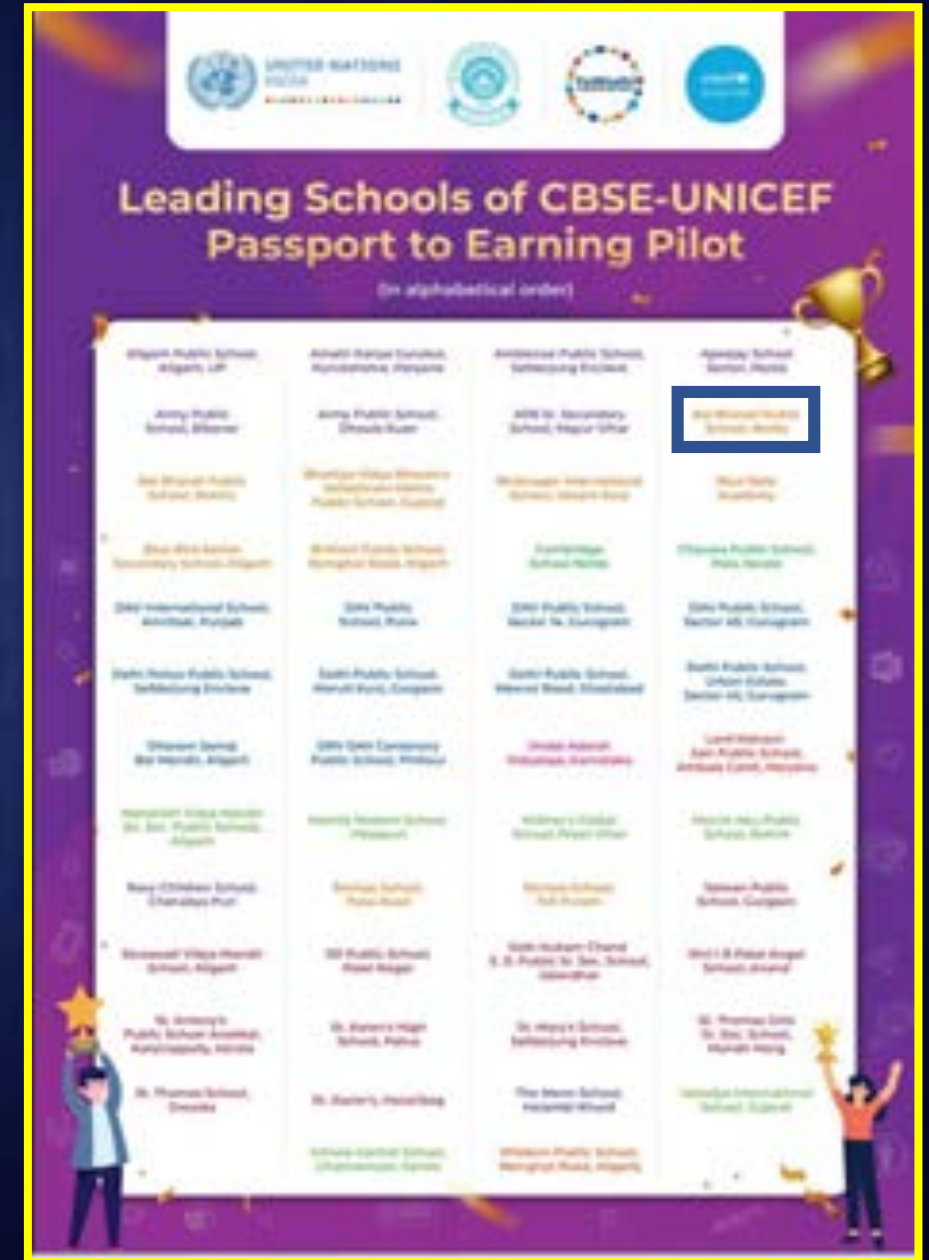

- The Annual examination for Classes V - XI commenced on 20 Feb, 2023 and are still underway.

# ACADEMICS

- Class I -IV students enrolled with CFSI appeared for Round IV exams held from 06 Dec, 2022 to Feb, 2023.
- Class V- XI students enrolled with CFSI are writing Final examination which started from 20 Feb, 2023.
- Class X & XII students enrolled with CFSI appeared for Pre- Board Examinations held in the month of December, 2022 and January, 2023.
- Class X & XII students enrolled with CFSI are currently appearing for Board Examinations.





## **PARENTAL INTERACTION**

Interactive PTM was held in the month of January and Feb, 2023 for students enrolled with CFSI. The Special Educator, and School Counselor discussed the results and the progress of the students.

## **SPECIAL EDUCATION SESSIONS**

- Online and offline sessions were conducted regularly by Special Educators for the comprehensive development of children with special needs.
- The sessions were made more interactive by using audio visual aids that have been recommended by NCERT and Diksha Portal.
- To hold the attention span of children with special needs sensory receptors like – clay, water games, sand games etc. along with puzzles were used.
- Peer mentoring and interactive teaching was encouraged to help the students increase their self-confidence.
- Special educators ensured that the mental and physical health of all students and their families is good.







# SCREENINGS, OBSERVATIONS AND ASSESSMENTS

- Cases referred by the class teachers were subjected to the process of preliminary screenings, wherein the students were observed for a period of 10-15 days.
- The methodology adopted was naturalistic observations, academic, and functional assessments.
- Concerns with context to developmental milestones, academic difficulty, socio-emotional or any other cognitive domain were addressed through assessments.
- Parental interaction was held to carry out psychological assessments of these students.

# CBSE ADOLESCENT SUMMIT 2022

The CBSE National Adolescent Summit on life skills, mental health and wellbeing took place at National Bal Bhavan, New Delhi from 15 to 17 Dec, 2022. The students participated in different competitions like mental health exhibition, Rhetoric's, Yuva Sansad and Movie screening. This platform gave the students an opportunity to put forward their understanding of mental health to others, they got to know the different aspects of mental health and how as peer educators they can help the students of CFSI. The school has 20 peer student educators to assist students of CFSI.



# International Day of Persons with Disability

The CFSI department organized a weeklong event for the entire school on International Day for Persons with Disability. The observance of the Day aims to promote an understanding of disability issues and mobilize support for the dignity, rights and well-being of persons with disabilities.

The department organized multiple events like poster making, morning assembly, best out of waste and Online sessions to create awareness amongst the students about Inclusion and Disability.

A special assembly on the topic "kindness" was conducted by the students of the CFSI department. They spoke to their fellow students about the importance of kindness and how acts of kindness can make the world a happier place for everyone.





## **CBSE EXAMINATION AND EVALUATION**

- The school is a centre for AISSE & AISSCE Examination, 818 regular school students of Classes X & XII are appearing for exams w.e.f. 15 Feb, 2023 to 05 April, 2023.
- The evaluation of Answer Scripts of Class XII in subjects, i.e. English (XII), Chemistry (XII), Economics (XII), Accountancy (XII), Hindi (X), Science (X), Social Science (X), FMM (X) and Maths (X) with School Principal as the Chief Nodal Supervisor will be held in School premises.
- 06 PGTs and 06 TGTs have been appointed as Head Examiners for evaluation work.

The School Alumni on a regular basis conducts experiential learning sessions for our students.

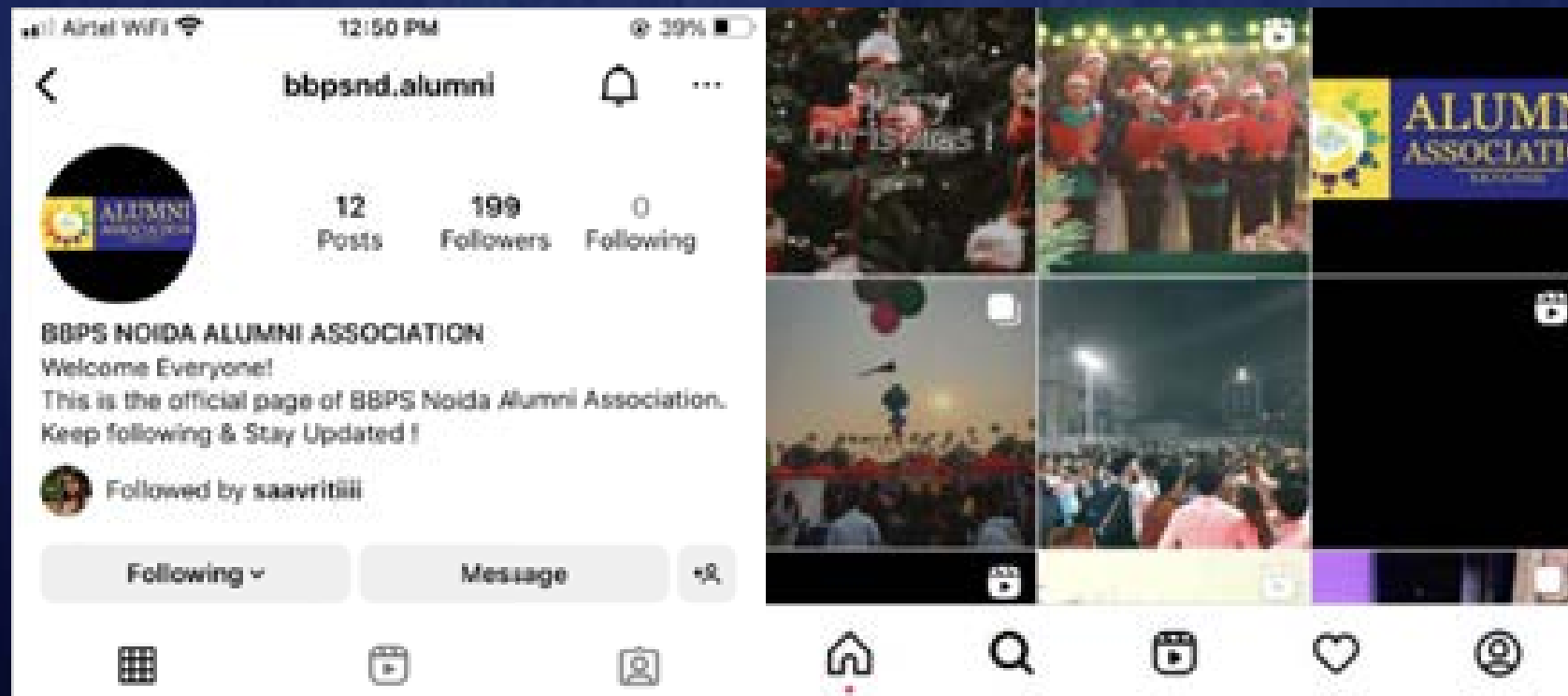

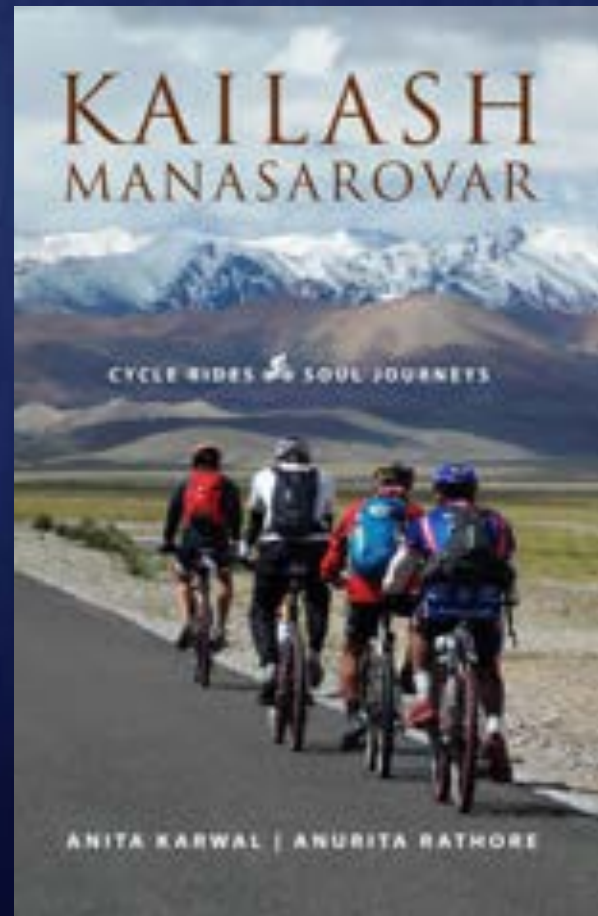
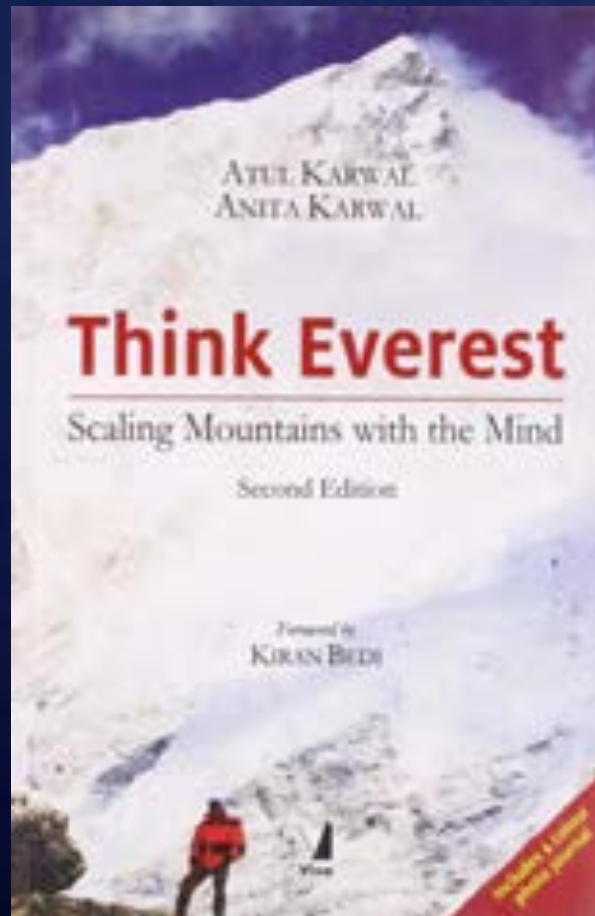
# TEACHER'S ACHIEVEMENTS

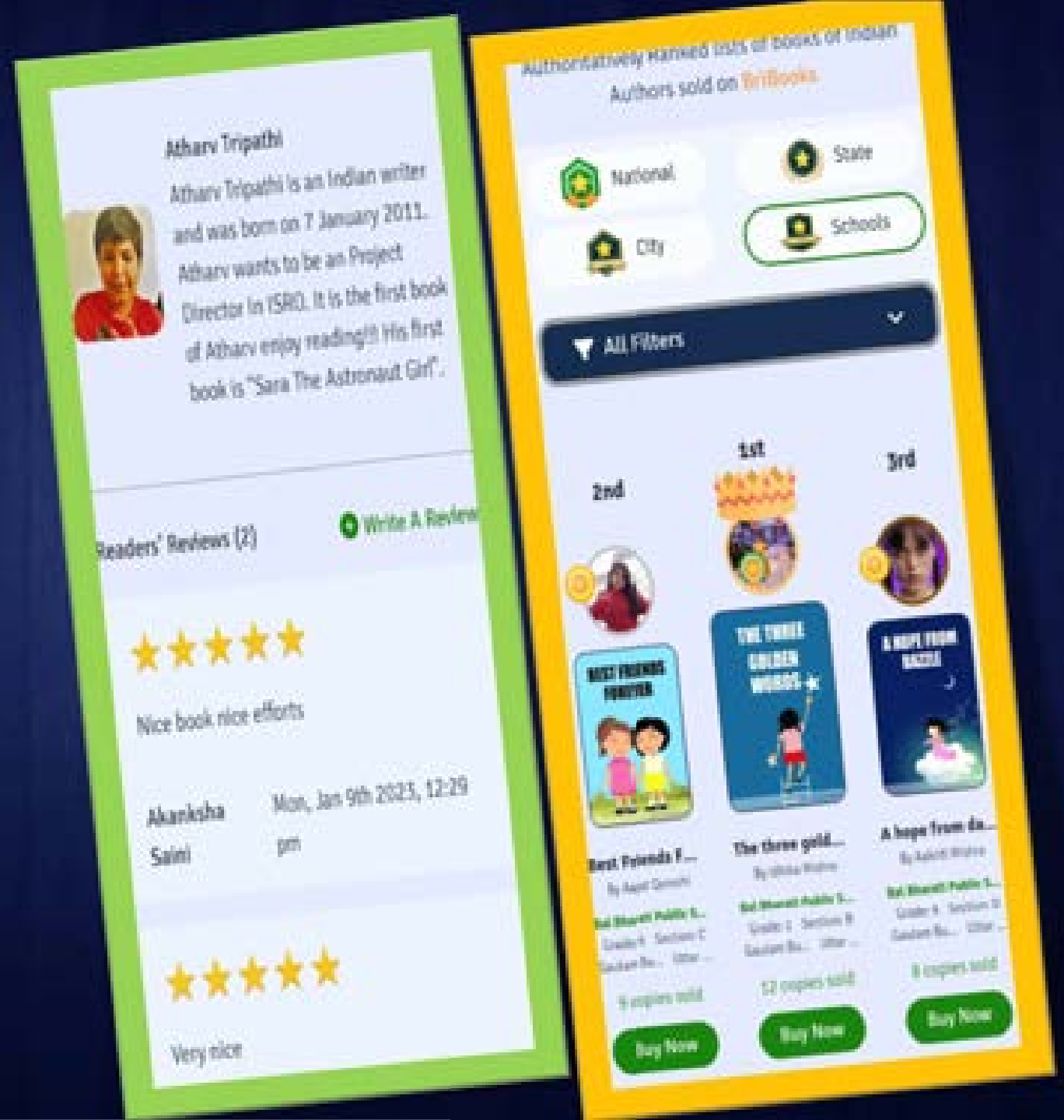
# TGIF:

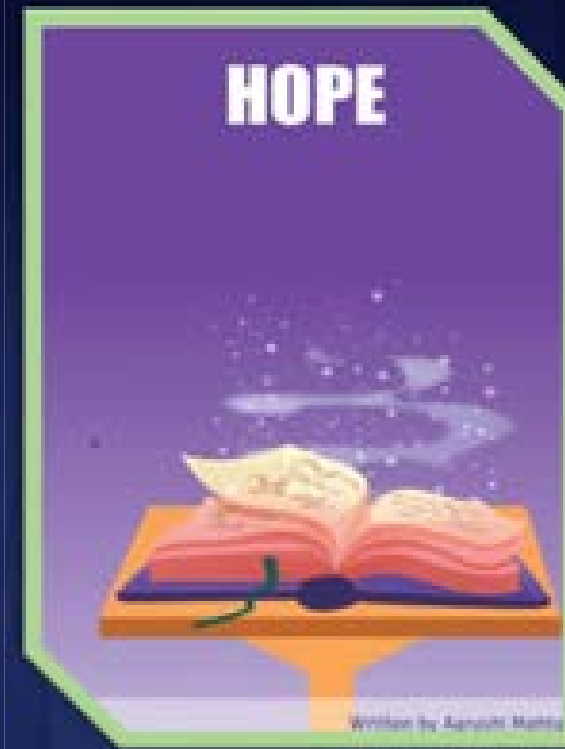


## National Young Authors Fair

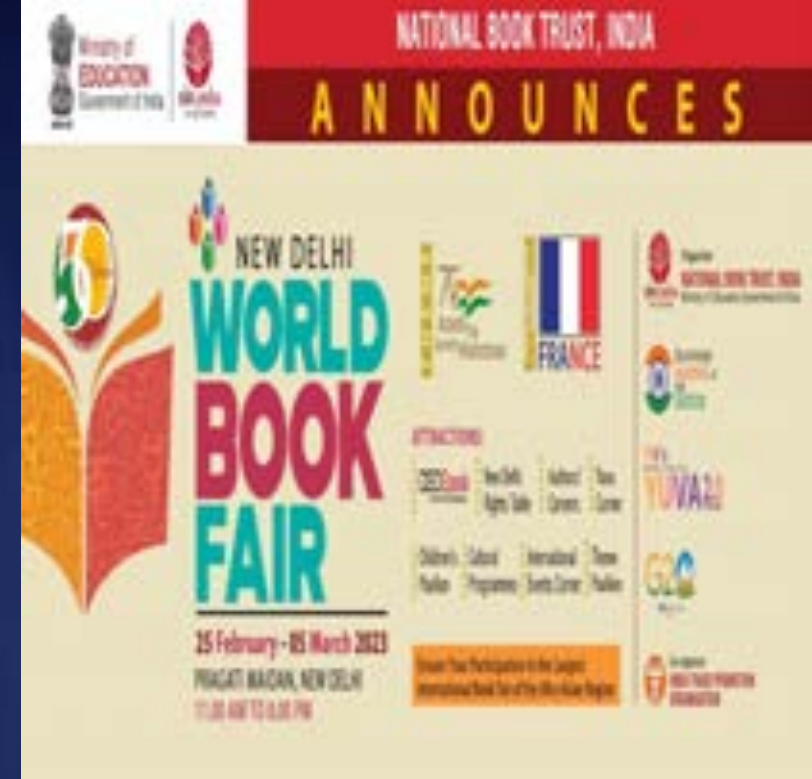

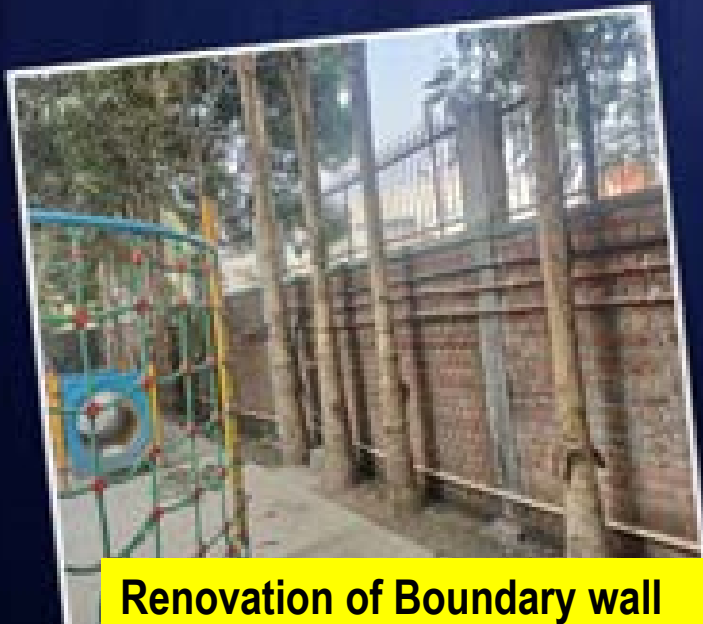

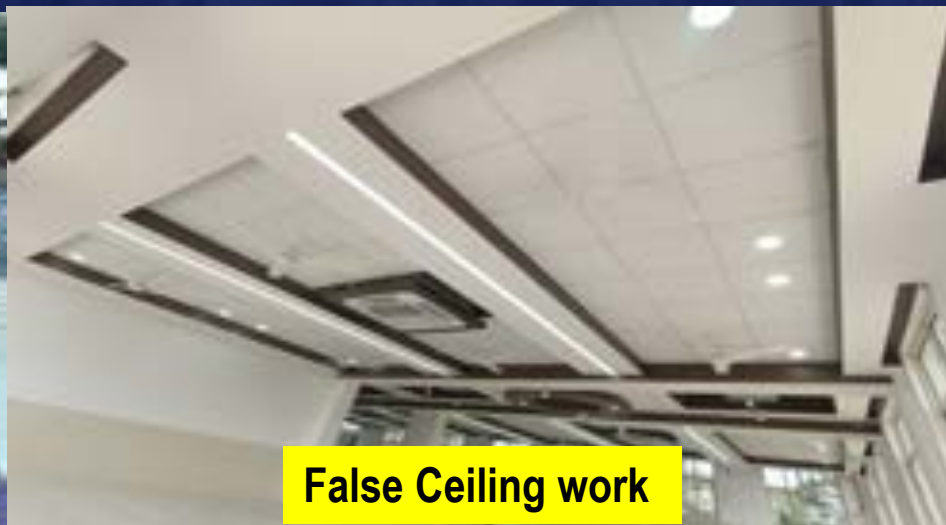
