

CRITERIA FOR CHAMPION READERS AWARD (Session 2023 - 2024) Applicable to CLASSES IV &V

The Champion Readers Award entails the following guidelines.

As a precursor, a list of twenty-one judiciously selected book titles in accordance with our young readers' age and interest will be compiled by the English Department of the Primary School. These exclusively selected books will be shared with the interested readers to be read during this academic session. (Most of the books are available in the school library for student's perusal.)

Selection Process:

- Interested students must enroll in Champion Reader's Club to be eligible for the Championship.
 - How to Enroll: Entrants to give their names to their class-teachers to get registered in the Champion Reader's Club.
- The competition will be conducted in two stages: Stage 1.) Preliminary Round; and Stage 2.) Final Round
 - a) Stage 1 Preliminary Round: For the Preliminary Round, an MCQ quiz will be conducted in the month of August-September'23. The quiz will be based on the 'Essential Reads' section from the list of Good Reads provided. Top ten students scoring between 70-90% will be selected for the Final Round.
 - b) Stage 2 Final Round: The final Round is a Book Discussion Round. This Round will have a panel discussion with the English faculty and Headmistress which will be conducted in the month of October.
- Weightage and preference will be given to participants who would read maximum number of books, other than the list of books provided in the 'Essential Reads'. (Here, reading books other than the ones mentioned is permitted, but the chosen book should hold merit.)
- Bonus Stage: The top scorers (Cumulative of stage I and stage II) will appear for a final interview with the Principal.
