Registration Process: Online

- The registration period is from June 10 to September 30, 2023.

- The registration is free and is open for all students studying in Classes VI XII.

Training Sessions:

- Registered students can access free training programs available on ASDC website https://www.asdc.orq.in/nao.
- The courses will focus on various aspects of a wide range of skills and competencies, and on successful completion a participation certificate will be awarded.
- Registered students will be able to access the sample paper on completion of their registration.

National Automobile Olympiad:

- 1. The Olympiad consists of three stages: City, Regional and National Finals.
- 2. The format for the 3 stages will be MCQ based Test, Online Live Quiz, and Workshop respectively.
- 3. The city and regional rounds will be conducted online.
- 4. The regional winners will advance to the finals which would be held in Delhi. All costs pertaining to the lodging and boarding will be borne by the organisers.
- 5. The exact date and venue for the finals will be communicated to the participating students in due course.
