DESCRIPTION OF THE ACTIVITY: Ikebana is the art of beautifully arranging cut stems, leaves, and flowers in vases and other containers that evolved in Japan over seven centuries. To arrange the stems and flowers exactly as one wishes, a familiarity with many different ways of fastening and positioning them is necessary. These techniques are what people attend ikebana classes to learn. Usually, three to five years are required to acquire these technical and expressive skills.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- * Two participants from each house
- Craft work must be an original piece, completed solely by the participants.
- A flower arrangement should be about 1 ½ to 2 times the height or length of the container.
- ***** Participants need to bring handmade flowers, buds, stems etc. from home.
- The medium for the creation of flowers and accessories are left to the choice of participants, they can use paper, cloth, foam, net etc.
- All necessary stuffs required for arrangement like the Vase, floral tapes, cello tapes, glue, fevicol, pins etc. need to be carried by the participants.

CRITERIA FOR JUDGEMENT:

- Use of material
- Overall Appearance of the design
- Creativity and Originality
- Height of the arrangement to the vase
