ACTIVITY TIME

Arrange and Glue: Arrange the cutouts on the paper, creating a winter-themed composition. Once satisfied, glue the pieces in place.


Add Details: Enhance the collage with additional elements like cotton balls for snow flakes and glittery border.






GRANDMA TALES...
