


"In the art of life, as in Rangoli, the beauty is in the intricate details and vibrant hues that come together to create a masterpiece."

THEME	: Geometrical Shapes-Kolam Rangoli

Rules and Regulations:

- Participation of all students is compulsory.
- Students should bring the required material (A4 sheet, colours etc.) from home.
- Students will draw a Kolam based Rangoli using geometrical shapes on Tamil culture and tradition. Kolam can be Rangoli but NO random designs filling in the entire drawing sheet or no extra fillings like using Glue or Glitter.
- Participants are not allowed to bringing preprinted designs, stencils, stickers to enhance the look. We encourage participants to draw a free hand Art. (No glue or Glitter).
- The main purpose of this competition is to enhance awareness of Tamil culture among students and to motivate creative expression of the given subject in the form of a painting or art.
- Art teachers are required to guide students during regular art periods.
- All the records to be maintained on the nominal rolls and **best one entry** from each section to be recorded on nominal roll by the respective class teacher.
