Children navigated through a web-like structure of ropes, testing their agility and coordination.

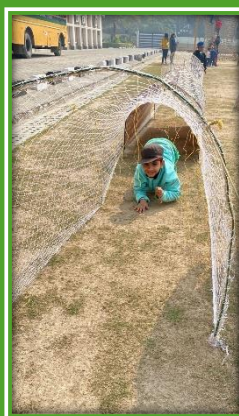
Burma Bridge: A suspended bridge made of ropes or planks, challenged children to maintain balance while crossing.
