DO'S AND DON'TS FOR THE PARENTS



- . Please read the contents of this diary carefully.
- Ensure that your ward has proper breakfast and reaches the school on time, at least 5
 minutes before the school begins. Children reporting later than the scheduled time on
 regular school days will be send back home.
- Strict adherence to prescribed uniform, dearliness and personal hygiene is to be ensured. It is advisable to sent an extra pair of undergarments in your ward's bag.
- Please send a tote bag containing swimming costume and a small towel (both neatly labelled) on the days specified for swimming in the time table.
- Please keep a kit of decorative materials/other stationery items handy to be sent whenever asked by the teacher.
- Healthy food, properly packed, is encouraged in the child's liftin box. A napkin and a mat too is recommended on daily basis.
- Please ensure that students do not bring mobile phones or any other electronic devices to school.
- Always write your ward's name, admission no, and class at the back of any cheque (asked by the school) and on every belonging of your child, including uniform.
- Ensure that your want carries student diary to the school every day. Please check the
 diary every day for any entries from the school. Also use the diary for official
 communication with the school. Ensure that the child shows the diary to the teacher.
 Parents should regularly check and acknowledge school circulars through the diary.
- . Please check the school website regularly for notification and updates.
- Monitor your ward's progress and feel free to meet the concerned teacher by taking prior appointment. Please refrain from directly visiting the classrooms at any time.
- Parents should ensure that they spend sufficient time daily with their wards to ensure
 a good level of understanding. Parent-Teacher Meetings should be utilised as a
 platform to interact with the teacher keeping in view the progress of the child.
- Adhere to school rules with respect to visiting hours/security.
- Intimate the school about any change in your address and telephone number (s). This
 information is vital in the interest of the safety of students.
- Be courteous to the school staff and polite and don't criticize the teachers in the presence of your child.
- Dignity should be maintained in the manner of dressing up whenever visiting the school.
- Please do not send gifts, sweets or biscuits or other eatables to distribute among children on your ward's birthday. Do not send your child to school in PartylCasual dress on birthday.
- Proper arrangements should be made for picking up small children from the bus stop.





- Regular attendance is essential for the academic and personal development of children. Parents are therefore, requested to make appointments with the doctor/dentist/pass port office only after school hours or during holidays.
- Parents are not permitted to take their children out of school for holidays during term exams except under exceptional circumstances after procuring permission from the head of the institution.
- All requirements of leave should be applied for in advance, through an application addressed to the Principal, except in case of emergency. Parent are also requested to fill up the proforma given in the diary.
- In case of undeclared holidays such as Eid, Muharram etc, the competition/examination will be held on the next, day. In case of a change parents will be informed timely.
- Students suffering form contagious diseases should not be sent to school, till the mandatory period of quarantine is over.
- On the day of unit test, if a student suffering from fever or contagious disease is sent to school he/she will be sent back home for rest and will be marked absent for day. The child should take test at home till the mandatory period of quarantine is over. Parents must refer to the Mismuster Policy for any test missed by their wards.
- Students must not wear any kind of jewellery / precious metals or gem stones.
- Students must not apply nail enamel, heavy designs of mehandi and kajal.
- It is mandatory for parents to carry the parent ID Card for all the meetings to school and ensure that their ward turn up in school uniform during the PTMs.
- If the student is short of 75% attendance, promotion to the next class will be prohibited. No separate reminders will be sent to parents/students in this regard.
- Regular medical check up is undertaken by the School Medical Officer. Parents are requested to kindly do the follow up (IFANY)






LUNCH ETIQUETTES

- 3. Send a handkerchief daily with your ward so that he/she can use it to wipe his/her mouth, face, hands after the lunch or as and when required by him/her.












