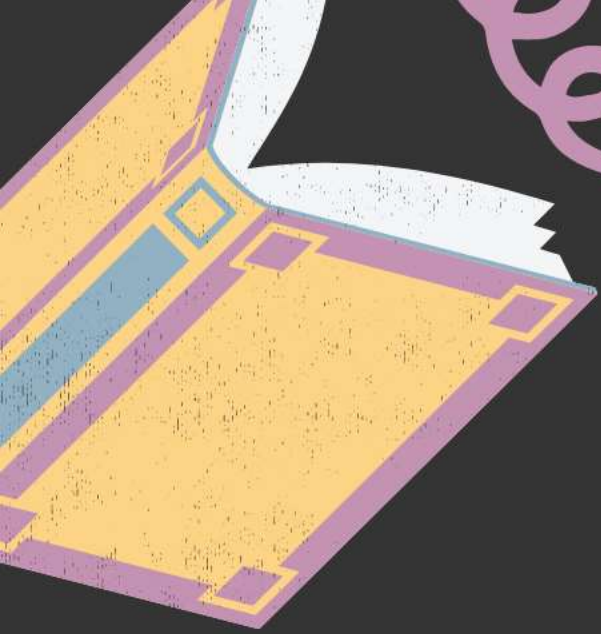

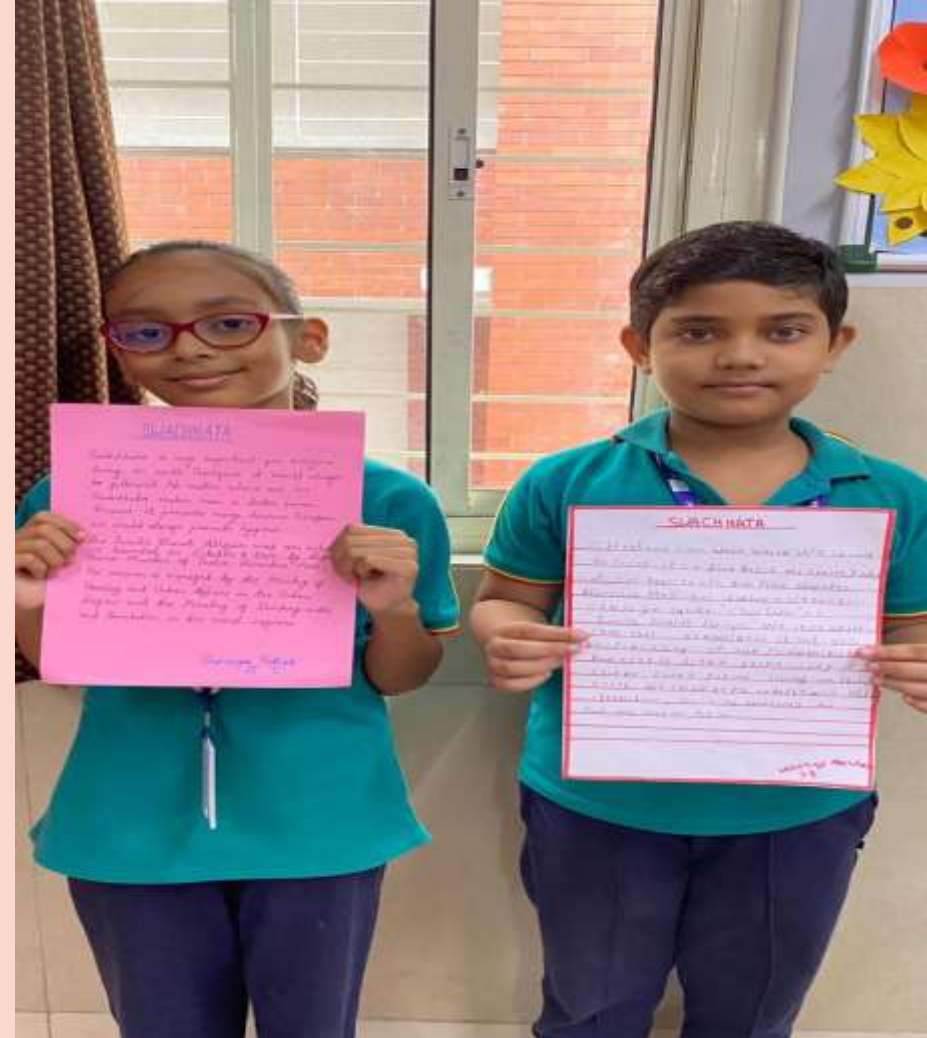

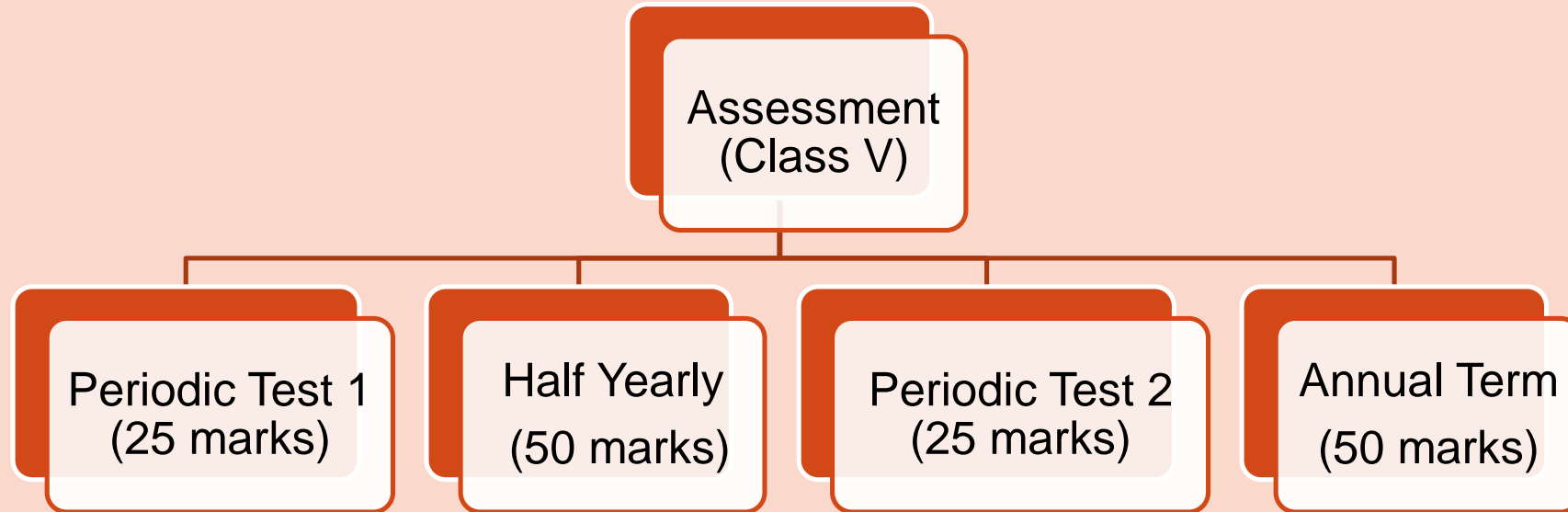


COMMENCEMENT OF CLASSES

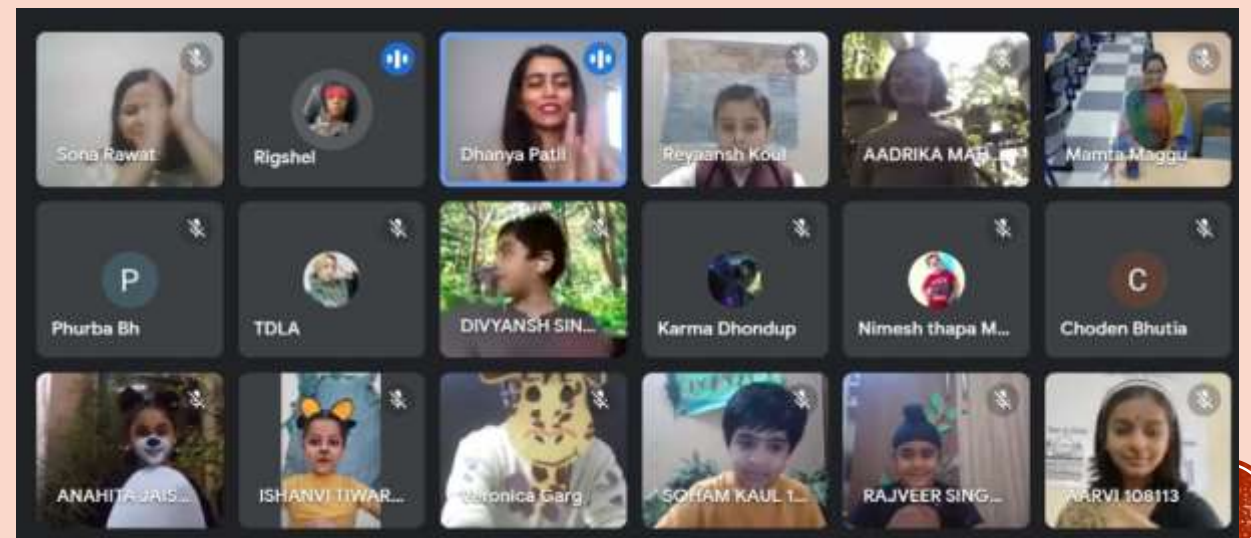
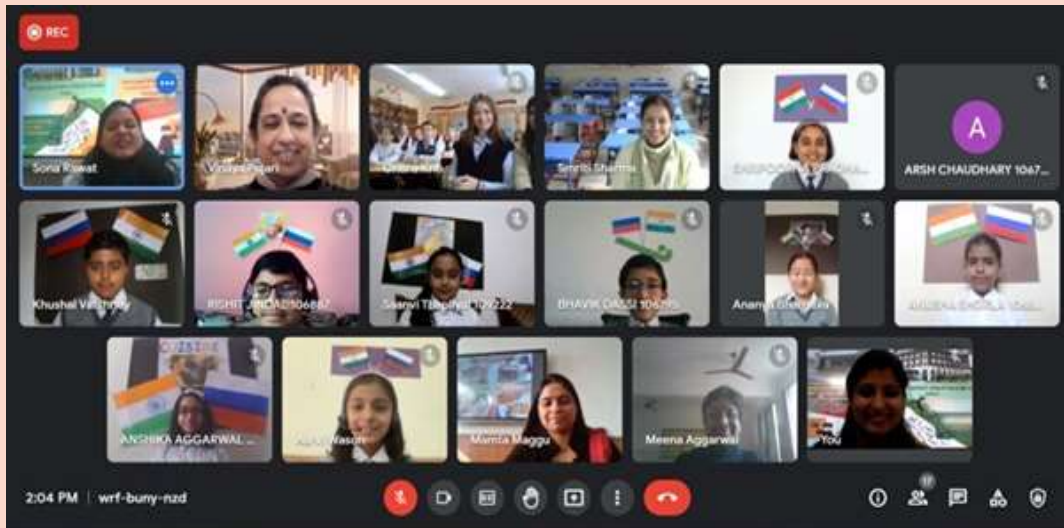

SCHOOL BAG WEIGHT POLICY 2020

RECOMMENDATIONS AND GUIDELINES FOR SCHOOLS

- It is recommended to follow universally accepted ratio of weight for school bag which is **10 per cent of the body weight** of the student across Classes I to X which is universally accepted.
- Table showing Class wise average body weight of the children:
