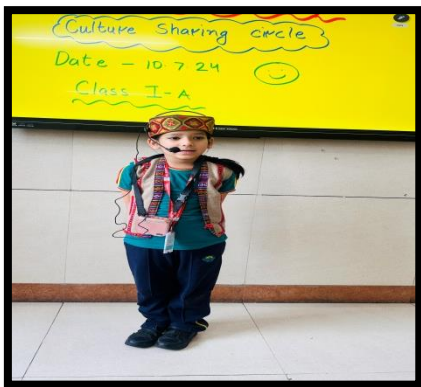
Theme: World Population Day
