



TRIP TO JIM CORBETT NATIONAL PARK (REMOTE VILLAGE)
BAURAUD TREK & NAINITAL

Dear Parent,

In continuation of our endeavor to expose school children to different experiences for their overall development, it is proposed to organize an Educational Excursion to Jim Corbett National Park (Remote Village) Bauraud Trek & Nainital. This trip promises to be an enriching experience, providing an opportunity for our students to connect with nature and learn about wildlife conservation efforts. Below are the details and instructions for the excursion:

The excursion will take place on 27 May, 2024 (for Class VIII) and 29 May, 2024 (for Classes IX – XII) departing at 05.00 a.m. from Bal Bharati Public School, Noida. Students must report to school on the day of the excursion at 04.30 a.m.

Students will travel by 2x2 deluxe AC coach, ensuring their safety and comfort throughout the journey.

TOUR ITINERARY

Day-1	: Departure to Jim Corbett at 05:00 am from school and arrive at Resort, Wild Crest by lunch time. In the evening Nature Trek to adjacent crystal clear mountain and river Kosi. Bonfire with music. Dinner at resort.
Day-2	: Depart for Nainital at 07.00 am, visit Baru Bazaar and Naina Devi temple. Lunch at Nainital. Evening back to Jim Corbett followed by dinner. Night at Resort.
Day-3	: Visit Corbett National Park, to enjoy Open Jeep Safari. One Naturalist Guide will narrate Corbett's flora and fauna while driving through the beautiful and secluded forest of Main Corbett National Park. After Breakfast depart by coaches to-Garjia Temple followed by Dhangari museum to watch Live 3D show of Corbett's wildlife. After lunch depart for School, Tea/Coffee & Snacks at Bikanerwala or McDonald's Gajraula, with good washroom facilities. Arrival to BBPS, NOIDA school campus by 7.00 PM to 8.00 PM.

Parents are requested to ensure that students pack the following:

- Comfortable clothing suitable for outdoor activities.
- Sunscreen, hats, and sunglasses for sun protection.
- Necessary medications (if any) with clear instructions.
- Water bottles and snacks (optional).
- Avoid carrying cell phones.

Rules and Guidelines:

- Students must adhere to the instructions provided by the accompanying teachers and guides.
- Students must keep track of their personal valuable belongings. The school will not be responsible for any lost and damaged items.
- Respect the wildlife and natural habitat of animals. Do not litter or disturb the flora and fauna of the region.
- Follow safety protocols during safari rides and outdoor activities.
- Maintain discipline and cooperate with fellow students and staff members.
