The Central Board of Secondary Education has launched the CBSE Reading App powered by Freadom to provide students a platform to engage in reading different types of stories and learning to write effectively. This app is designed to make reading an engaging and rewarding experience for students of all ages. Through this app, CBSE students, teachers and schools will have access to a large digital library, consisting of reading material for Nursery Grades to Grade VIII, sourced from diverse set of publishers in text, audio and video formats.

The CBSE Reading App aligns with the NEP's goals of recognizing the need to develop higher order skills such as creativity, critical thinking, problem solving, visualization, and idea generation, by providing a well-designed, leveled and adaptive, one-stop platform.

Follow the instructions mentioned below on how to download and install the app: -

- B.** Search for "CBSE Reading APP by Freadom"

1. On APP Store or Play Store.
2. Install the app.
3. Open the app and click on 'Get Started' button.

- C.** As the summer vacations approach, the CBSE Reading App can be leveraged to engage learners in a variety of activities and enhance their key language competencies. Students can access a large digital library, consisting of reading material for Nursery Grades to Grade VIII, through the use of this app.
