

Circular No.21/2024-25 Date: 08 May, 2024

MATHEMATICS (041) IN CLASS – XI FOR ACADEMIC SESSION 2024-25

Dear parents,

In light of the recent developments and in adherence to circular No. Acad-03/2019 dated 10.01.2019, CBSE announced the following decision regarding the offering of Mathematics courses in Class 11th for the academic session 2024-25.

As per the circular mentioned above, students of Class X who pursued Mathematics Standard (041) were eligible to offer Mathematics (041) in Class XI, while those who opted for Mathematics Basic (241) were directed to take up Applied Mathematics (241) in Class XI. However, due to the unforeseen challenges posed by the Covid-19 pandemic, CBSE had granted an exemption allowing students who studied Mathematics Basic in Class X to opt for Mathematics (041) in Class XI/ XII.

Continuing with this exemption and considering the proposed changes stemming from the National Education Policy (NEP), the Board has decided to extend this relaxation for the academic session 2024-25. Hence, students who offered Mathematics Basic (241) in Class X will be permitted to pursue Mathematics (041) in Class XI.

However, it is imperative that before granting permission for Mathematics (041) in Class XI to such students, the Head of the Institution/School will ensure that the students possess the necessary aptitude to undertake Mathematics (041) at the Class XI level.
