Overview of the Workshop

Session 1	: Business Fundamentals and Investment Strategies
Facilitator	: C.A Rajat Maheshwari

Rajat Maheshwari began the seminar by guiding the young learners through the foundational concepts necessary for starting a business. He covered various business structures such as sole proprietorship and partnerships, emphasizing the importance of understanding limited and unlimited liabilities. Additionally, he explained key financial concepts including assets and company acts.

To make the session engaging and relatable, Rajat referenced popular investment shows like "Shark Tank," illustrating different investment strategies. He conducted an interactive segment where he clarified doubts about shares, their values, and operations, providing practical insights into the stock market.





Session 2: Understanding Financial Markets Facilitator: C.F.A Priyam Mendiratta

Priyam educated the students on the types of markets, including Capital, Primary, Secondary, and Nationalized Markets. Priyam further elaborated on the distinctions between active and passive investors, stocks, and debts. The session concluded with practical guidelines on how to buy mutual funds and invest in shares, providing the students with a comprehensive understanding of the investment landscape.

The interactive nature of both sessions ensured that the students were actively engaged and had their queries addressed comprehensively. The workshop was instrumental in equipping aspiring stock auditors with the essential skills and knowledge needed for their future careers.
