Participation and Group Formation:

- **Compulsory Participation:** All students from Classes III to V are to participate in this competition.
- **Group Formation:** Class teachers will create mixed-ability groups of 6-8 students by September 20th, 2024. This ensures ample time for brainstorming and collaboration.

Competition Format:

- **Designing the Product (First BSA Period):**
 - **Material Collection:** All group members are encouraged to bring in various waste materials from home that could be potentially useful for the project.
 - **Product Creation:** During the first BSA period, all students from each group will use the collected materials to design and create a functional or decorative product. The provided website (<https://www.fevicreate.com/web/fevcreate/-/blog/art-and-craft/best-out-of-waste-craft>) can be used for reference.
- **Product Presentation (Second BSA Period):**
 - **Presentation Team:** During the second period of BSA, all students from each group will be responsible for presenting their group's creation to the class.
 - **Duration of the presentation:** The time limit of the presentation shall be 2 to 3 minutes.

- **Content:** The presentation should highlight the following aspects (maximum duration: 2-3 minutes):
 - Creativity involved in the product's design
 - Functionality and purpose of the product
 - Effective utilization of waste materials
- **Judging Criteria:**
 - Products will be judged based on a pre-determined point system:
 - Creativity: 3 Marks
 - Functionality: 3 Marks
 - Presentation Skills: 4 Marks (including clarity, enthusiasm, and adherence to time limit)
- **Winners:** The names of the members of the best teams from each section will be recorded on the nominal roll and submitted to the respective D-section teachers for final judgment.
- **Final Round:** The date of the final round is 3rd October. The same presentation, from the preliminary round, will be used in the final round. Each team will have a time limit of 2 to 3 minutes to present their final creation (created and presented during the BSA periods) in front of the judging committee. The presentation should focus on creativity, functionality, and effective use of waste materials.
- **Decision:** The judges' decision will be final and binding.
