**Purpose:** The main objective of the Caring Hands activity was to promote the values of kindness, compassion, and empathy among students. ## **Highlights of the activity:**

- **Final Round Presentation:** On 10th December 2024, the selected students showcased their handprint designs in the final round. Each student had 2 minutes to explain the meaning behind their artwork, highlighting the messages of empathy and compassion they had expressed.
- **Judging and Reflection**: The judges evaluated the finalists on creativity, clarity of message, and the overall impact of their designs. The event culminated in a heart-warming display of empathy, where students shared their thought process behind the artwork and how small acts of kindness can make a significant difference, reinforcing the values of care and compassion.
