Learning Objectives

The child will be able to:

- ✓ understand the importance of cleanliness- that why being clean is essential for their health and well-being.
- ✓ practice good hygiene habits.
- ✓ understand how cleanliness contributes to a healthy home, school and community.
- ✓ develop a positive attitude towards cleanliness.
- ✓ know that one of the goals of Gandhiji, was cleanliness.



RULES AND REGULATIONS

- It will be a group activity (entire class)
- The facilitator will show the images of clean and dirty pictures & will ask children to identify the differences.
- Once the children have told the difference, the facilitator will relate cleanliness to their daily activities. For eg. keeping the surroundings neat & clean, washing hands before meals is important to prevent germs.
- Next the facilitator will ask the children to make their classroom the way it was before the lunch break (very clean and tidy). The facilitator may show a picture of a messy room before and after it's cleaned.
- The facilitator will ask the children to clean- the bits of papers, wrappers, pencil shavings by throwing them into dustbin & this way, games or activities can be organized that promote cleanliness, like a "clean-up" game.

- Additional information- the facilitators can tell the children about the father of our nation- **Gandhiji**, he saw cleanliness as a way to develop self-discipline and responsibility emphasizing the importance of keeping our homes, schools and communities clean.
