CRISIS MEDICAL SITUATION

(FOR STAFF OF BBPS, NOIDA)

Dear Staff,

Refer to the medical alert notification circulated to the Parent and relevant information.

Following will be the system of efficient and expert handling of emergency and crisis medical situations to be adopted by the staff of BBPS (Noida).

It is assumed that all students attending the school are healthy and fit to cope up with the school routine. The **School Nurse/Doctor** shall attend all cases of accidents, illness and any other medical emergency that occur during the course of the day.

All teachers and other staff are expected to use their practical sense at all times, particularly in emergencies (crisis medical situation) to ensure welfare of children in school.

At the same time, all teachers who may or may not be on duty, are responsible for ensuring that all accidents and injuries in the school are promptly attended to and the case summary is recorded in the Medical Room register. The teacher reporting the crisis to the MI Room shall append her signatures after the staff Nurse has recorded the Casualty Report in the register.

A daily message will be sent to parents if their child visits the Medical Room. This message will include details of the treatment provided by the doctor, along with any medication administered, and will be shared with parents on the same day.

We ensure adequate adult supervision in Swimming Pool area at all times. In case of casualty in Swimming Pool Lifeguard / Teacher on duty will raise an alarm, resuscitate the child with CPR and shift him/her to Medical Room. <u>https://bbpsnoida.balbharati.org/video-gallery/</u>

If in the opinion of the duty teacher, an injury requires immediate examination by the Nurse/Doctor, he/she will shift the child to the Medical Room and inform the parent immediately. All casualty matters are to be reported to the Reporting Officers (PPL / VPL / HMs) on an immediate basis.

HEAD AND SPINAL INJURIES, ASTHAMA ATTACKS, FRACTURES, INJURIES WITH BLOOD OR OPEN WOUNDS, EYE INJURIES, EPILEPSY, JUVENILE DIABETES are to be regarded as 'serious' in the first instance.

<u>ACTION</u>: Parents are to be informed immediately and the Principal notified. The Staff Nurse / Doctor and the teacher on duty will ensure that specialized aid is made available to the injured student and transfer the casualty to **KAILASH HOSPITAL** – **EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT**. The concerned staff will leave the hospital premises only upon handing over of the child to the parent.

In less serious cases, <u>i.e. a CUT WITH MINIMAL BLEED, DISLOCATION, SWELLING, RASH</u> WITH ITCH, TEMPERATURE OF 100°C AND ABOVE, WITH CORONA SYMPTOMS, VOMITING OR DIARRHEA, ACUTE PAIN THAT REQUIRES MEDICATION FOR RELIEF, parents will be informed by the class teacher to collect their child from the school and arrange for further treatment.

Further, this is for information of the staff, that the School Medical Room stores only **ANTACIDS**, **ORAL REHYDRATION FLUID, ANTI ALLERGY TABLETS, EXTERNAL USE CREAMS AND IRRIGATION SOLUTION FOR EYES AND WOUNDS.** Class teachers through parent(s) are required to notify the staff Nurse, if any student of their class has any allergy to any of the above medicines.

<u>CONCLUSION</u> : A SCHOOL WOULD GIVE ALL ITS 3000+ STUDENTS THE CARE AND ATTENTION THAT A PRUDENT PARENT WOULD.
