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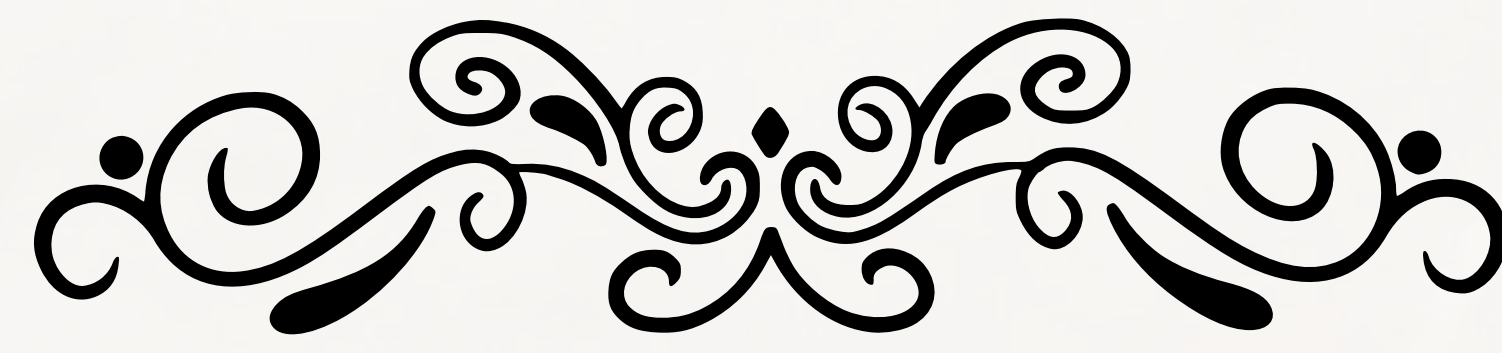
“Celebrating India’s Heartbeat through the Spirited Performances”

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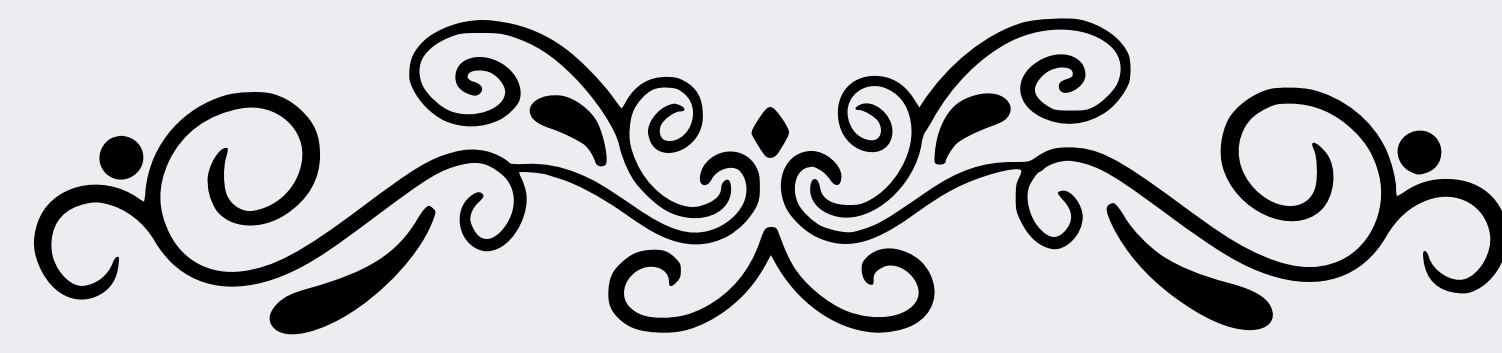

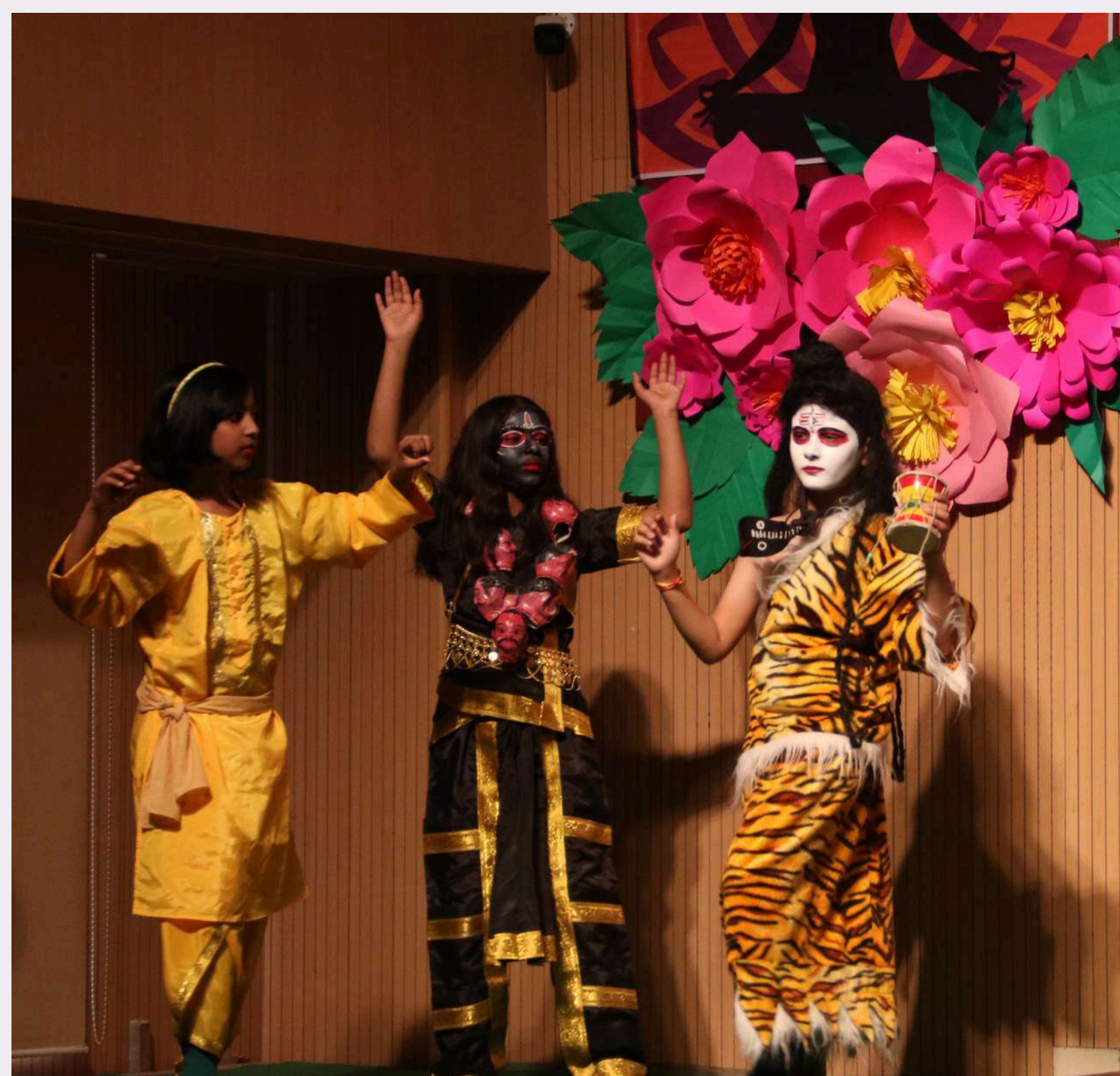

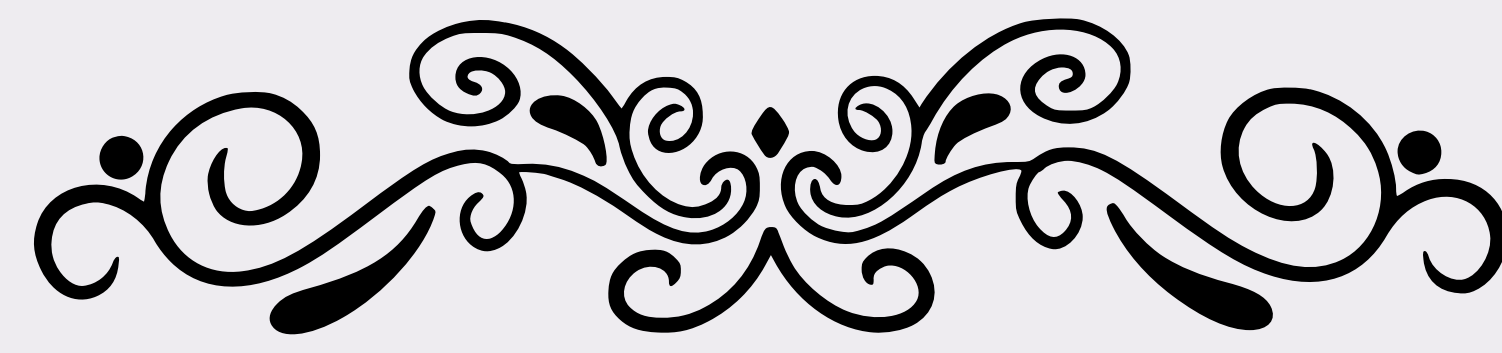
THE GRAND CONCLUSION

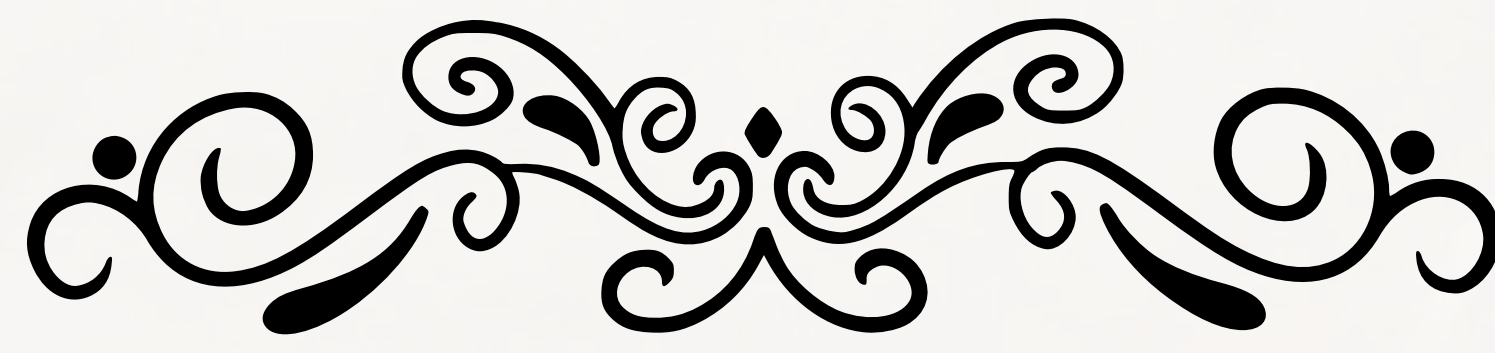
