Purpose of Visit: The purpose of an adventure camp for children is to provide a safe and engaging environment where kids can develop essential life skills through outdoor activities and challenges. HIGHLIGHTS OF THE VISIT:

<u>Commando Net</u>: Children navigated through a web-like structure of ropes, testing their agility and coordination.

<u>Hamster Wheel</u>: Children walked or ran inside a large, rotating wheel, emphasizing physical fitness and coordination.

<u>Hopscotch</u>: A traditional game involving hopping through a series of numbered squares, promoted balance, coordination, and agility.

<u>Magical Maze</u>: A maze-like structure where children navigated through twists and turns, testing their spatial awareness and problem-solving skills.

<u>Hipty Hop Race</u>: A fun race where children hopped on one foot while maneuvering through obstacles, enhancing balance and coordination.

<u>Laser Beam</u>: Children navigated through a series of laser beams without breaking them, challenging their agility and spatial awareness.

<u>Double Rope Bridge</u>: Children carefully crossed the double rope bridge, gripping the upper rope tightly while balancing their small feet on the lower one. Their faces lit up with excitement and determination as they navigated the wobbly challenge.

<u>Tyre Swing</u>: Children enjoyed swinging on a suspended tyre, encouraging balance, coo<mark>rdination, and proprioception.</mark>

<u>Zipline</u>: Children slid down a suspended cable, experiencing a thrilling ride while conquering any fear of heights.
