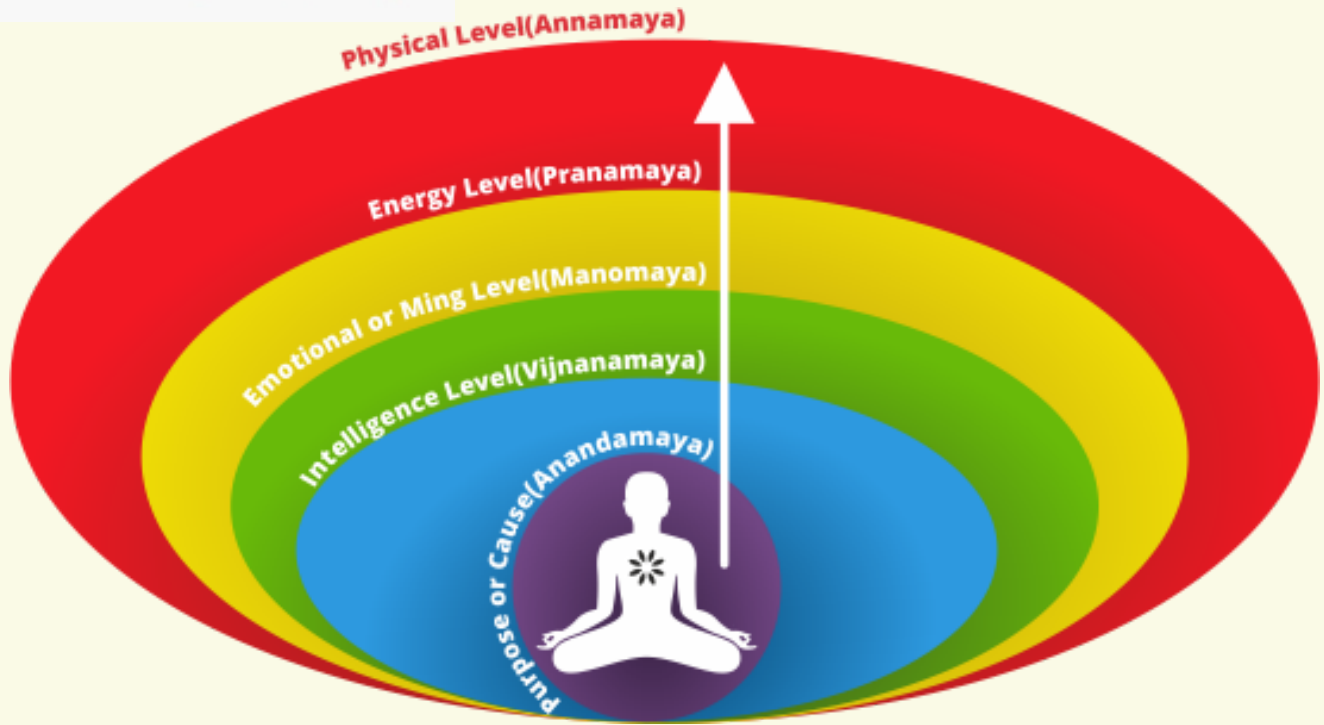
Warm greetings and a heartfelt welcome to the Bal Bharati family!

JOINING

TIMINGS

The school timings for Pre School are 08.50 a.m to 12.50 p.m. It is desired that parents drop their wards in school on time. The entry for students commence from 8.40 am and the school gate closes at 8.50 am sharp.

PARENT AND STUDENT ID CARD

You are requested to forward the soft copy of passport-size photographs (Specifications – size 2 inch x 2.5 inch, plain white background) of the Child, Mother and Father as the same is required for the generation of the Student and Parent ID cards on the e-mail id, bbps.admission@nd.balbharati.org latest by 10 March, 2025.

The format for the submission of photographs is as under :

A timely submission of photographs will help us to deliver ID Cards on time.

Keeping in view the safety of your child, it is mandatory for the child to wear Identity Card with the School Uniform on all working days (Monday – Friday)

TRANSPORT



The students of the Pre Primary wing can travel to the school only in the following manner:

- School Bus
- Own Arrangement (Escorted)
- The School does not encourage parents to opt for Private Vans as a mode of transport due to safety and security reasons.

The school also has a GPS tracking system to keep the parents informed about the movement of the school buses and their arrival time.



PARENT ID CARD



For safety and security, all parents **MUST** carry the Parent ID Card while picking up their wards from the bus stops. In case the parents are not in the possession of the Parent ID Card, the student will not be dropped at the bus stop and will be brought back to the school.

In case the child is being picked up by any other person other than the parents, an authority letter addressed to the School Principal is to be sent to the Class Teacher.

GUIDELINES FOR EXCEPTIONAL STUDENT PICKUP FROM SCHOOL TRANSPORT

Also, please be informed that the Parents / Guardians of the students using school transport desirous of taking their child/ward under exceptional circumstances, may do so with the express permission of the PRINCIPAL.

The request, addressed to the School Principal is to be put up at least 2 days in advance on the school's e-mail IDs.

This has been necessitated keeping in mind the prevailing law and order situation. As a policy matter, no half-day leave is granted from the school.

IT MAY BE NOTED THAT, THE SCHOOL TRANSPORT IS THE SAFEST MODE OF TRAVELLING, AS ALL STUDENTS TRAVELLING IN SCHOOL BUS ARE ACCOMPANIED BY A TEACHER AND A LADY ATTENDANT ON DUTY, BOTH IN MORNING AS WELL AS AFTERNOON ROUTES.

ENCOURAGING HYGIENE AND GOOD HABITS

TABLE MAT & APRON



Parents should send 01 (properly labelled) Apron and 01 Table Mat to the school every day for their child's personal use. The class teachers ensure that the children use their Aprons and Table Mats while having their tiffin. The same must be washed twice a week to maintain proper hygiene. It will help the school reinforce the habits if the Table Mat and Napkin is spread for the child at home during her/his meal time.

TOILET TRAINING SUPPORT: ENSURING COMFORT FOR YOUR CHILD

We expect that the students of Pre School are toilet trained. However, in exceptional cases, if the child is undergoing toilet training, it is advised that an extra diaper be sent along, neatly packed, in the child's school bag. An extra pair of undergarments are also to be sent along with the child in the school bag.

AVOID VALUABLES: ENSURING SAFETY AT SCHOOL

Valuables/Jewellery/ Fancy wristwatches / clips etc. are not to be carried / worn by the children to school. The school will not be responsible for any damage/loss of such articles.

MEDICAL ALERT NOTIFICATION

- Parents are required to download the Medical Alert Notification Proforma from the School Website <http://bbpsnoida.balbharati.org/download-forms-docs/> and submit the same along with essential documents to the Class Teacher of the child latest by **30 April 2025**.
- Also, in case of a long sickness of more than 2-3 days, the school needs to be informed through an e-mail / letter, addressed to the School Principal, with regard to the nature of illness and the number of days the student is likely to be away from school. Ensuring the safety and well-being of all our students, parents are requested that students suffering from cold, cough, fever or any other contagious diseases should not be sent to school, till the mandatory period of quarantine is over.

A FITNESS CERTIFICATE IS TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE CLASS TEACHER, ISSUED BY A REGISTERED MEDICAL PRACTITIONER, WHEN A CHILD JOINS BACK SCHOOL AFTER A PROLONGED ILLNESS.

MEDICAL ALERT NOTIFICATION

Dear Parents,

It is only a "Good Health" that prevents overall well-being of a child. With a view to ensuring reaction time in providing emergency medical assistance to students who require such help it is requested that the school has data regarding such cases.

Parents of children with health related issues are requested to furnish the following information regarding the state of health of their wards:

- History of illness
- Medication prescribed by Registered Doctor and duly consumed by parents for administration of the same to the school in case of emergency
- If there is a need to administer medicine during school hours, such medicines to be delivered in a container duly labelled to the Head Teacher
- Check for such medicine should not be for more than 15 days
- Change ANTIBIOTIC courses to vary initiation with doctor's written advice for self administration
- Regular school attendance to ensure the optimal learning. However, a mere presence at school does not ensure effective learning. A child must be feeling well in order to maximize learning experience. In addition, a child who is sick and comes to school may spread the illness to other students. It is recommended that a child remains at home if any of the following conditions are present:
 - Temperature of 100° or higher
 - Vomiting and/or Diarrhea with a loss of Appetite and/or Force
 - Any acute that requires emergency medication for relief
 - Chronic condition: Relapse of any
 - A rash that is itchy and spreading and of unknown cause.
- Please note, if your ward is a part of SCHOOL SPORTS TEAM, but is suffering from any contagious illness the school Doctor will readily clear the student for participation. The student will be allowed to participate in SPORTS and activities cleared by the School Doctor.
- In the event of a serious accident an emergency service will be arranged at once and the parents will be contacted immediately. A member of the teaching staff, usually Home Room Teacher will accompany the casualty to the Hospital Emergency Department. In less serious cases, parents will be requested to collect their child from the school and arrange for further treatment. In all emergency situations, in order to ensure the safety of all children, the school emergency procedures and after the completion of the process, this will be communicated to the Head Teacher and the School Doctor.
- Working off duty Medications to always be in the pocket of child.

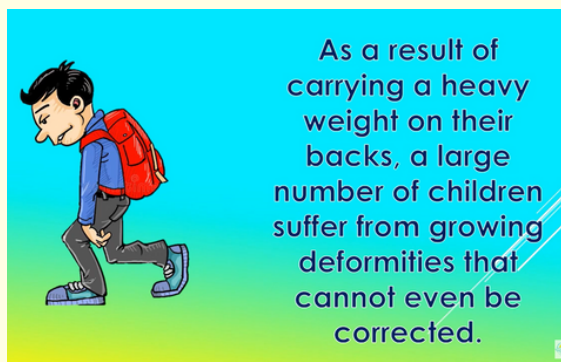
