The School provides Airconditioned transport facilities to students on 26 routes (Classes I-XII) and 6 routes in the Pre primary wing, covering most of the areas/sectors across Noida, Indirapuram and the adjoining areas of Delhi

To secure the transport service, kindly ensure that the transport requisition form is submitted to the respective class teachers.
