(Under the aegis of Child Education Society)

INCENTIVE SCHEME FOR SPECIAL ACHIEVERS IN SPORTS & GAMES SESSION: 2024-25

The purpose of providing an Incentive/Scholarships scheme for meritorious students in sports, needs consideration of the rankings of each child from Sub-Junior, Junior and Senior categories, as well as participation in tournaments of recognized associations and federations.

A. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- 1. The Scheme applies to all students enrolled with Bal Bharati Public Schools.
- 2. The Scholarship Awardee should consistently participate and excel in the given games and sports as per the policy enumerated below.
- 3. The student's performance will be evaluated based on their rankings in Sub Junior, Junior and Senior categories, as recognized by the relevant National or State Sports Associations / Federations or recognised and funded by Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports.
- 4. Only recognized Sports Associations affiliated with the School Games Federation of India (SGFI) or other National Sports bodies should be considered for Rankings.
- 5. The SPORTS CONCESSION can be availed for Team Event (s) and Individual events.

B. PROCESS OF AVAILING SPORTS SCHOLARSHIPS

- 1. Sports Athletes need to submit their achievement documents to the School Principal latest by 10 Apr, 2024.
- 2. Evaluation of the submitted documents will be done by the <u>Scholarship Panel</u> of respective schools.
- 3. Scholarships and Incentives for **New Admissions** will be evaluated based on their performance in previous year, provided that all necessary documents are submitted.

I. NON-MONETARY REWARDS

Top performers in various 'Sports and Games' at International / National /State / CBSE competitions will be nominated for the school's prestigious 'Athlete of the year Award'.

The names and photographs of exceptional achievers will be showcased on the school website and highlighted in the monthly or quarterly newsletters of the school, Sports Council or CES.

J. ACADEMIC SUPPORT

- The school will recognize the efforts of Sports students who hold national positions by offering academic support. The support includes flexible schedules for playing various tournaments and extra tutoring, or accommodations for missed classes or exams due to sports commitments.
- Counselling session to encourage a balanced approach to education and sports, enabling students to pursue both without compromising either will be provided to parents as well as student by the school.
- Re laxation in attendance for the period that the student is attending training camp or going to participate in any competition sponsored by the school.

K. OTHER ALLOWANCE AND PERMISSIBLE FOR SPORTS TEAMS

- Team participating in any competition outside Delhi/NCR in a recognized competition shall be entitled to travel by AC 3-tier train including Shatabdi and Rajdhani and the train fare shall be borne entirely by the school.
- School team or the individual player participating in a recognized International tournament in any part of the world shall be entitled to Air Travel (Economy class) concession upto 50%. The Coach / Manager travelling with the team shall also be entitled for 50% Air travel concession (Economy Class). However, prior approvals for participation of the team/individual in any International competition should be obtained from the Secretary and Chairman of the school.
- Team Manager/Coach travelling with the team shall be eligible for three tier A C train fair. School shall bear the expenses.
- Team members including Coach / Teacher / Manager shall be entitled for refreshment @ Rs. 100/- per head, (maximum) participating in any local recognized sports competitions, sponsored by the school.
- Rs. 500/- per day per person is allowed for food & refreshments for out station recognized tournaments.
- In exceptional cases, where lodging and boarding in CBSE Schools is unsatisfactory, a sum of Rs. 2000/- (for 2 players) per room will be permissible on seeking approval from Secretary (Manager) / Competent Authority.

A COMMITTEE OF TEACHERS, COACHES AND SCHOOL PRINCIPAL WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR SEAMLESS IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SCHOOL INCENTIVE POLICY.
