STRUCTURE OF CUET

The CUET (UG) - includes three main components:

A. Languages (List A):

Candidates must appear in at least one language they studied in Class XII.

(Section 1A and 1B- languages: The languages offered in CUET 2025 are Tamil, Telugu, Kannada, Malayalam, Marathi, Gujarati, Odia, Bengali, Assamese, Punjabi, English, Hindi, and Urdu.)

C. General Aptitude Test (GAT):

Consists of General Knowledge, Current Affairs, Logical and Analytical Reasoning, and Quantitative Reasoning (This section can be opted by candidates for discontinued subjects, Vocational/Open Eligibility/Cross Stream/any other as applicable UG courses. It is an optional section that the candidate can choose as per the requirement)

Important Guidelines

- Admissions to all undergraduate programs at the University of Delhi will be based on CUET (UG) - 2025 scores, except for the School of Open Learning (SOL), Non-Collegiate Women Education Board (NCWEB), and Foreign Nationals.
- Admissions for supernumerary quotas (CA, Sports, PwD, etc.) will also be determined through CUET
- It is mandatory for candidates to appear in CUET (UG) - 2025 in the subjects they studied in Class XII
