



MANDATORY 50 HOURS OF CONTINUOUS PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT (CPD) – 2024-25

In accordance with the **National Education Policy (NEP) 2020** and **CBSE guidelines**, all teachers must complete **50 hours of Continuous Professional Development (CPD)** annually. This initiative aims to enhance professional skills, keep educators updated with modern teaching methodologies, and maintain high educational standards.

Out of the **50 hours**, training is categorized as follows:

- **25 Hours by CBSE** (As per Notification 16/2021)
- **25 Hours by School** (As per Notification 16/2021)

Professional Growth & Development (14 Hrs) – CBSE delivers 3 hrs, and schools handle 11 hrs, including research, mentoring, and academic. Alternative CPD Credit Activities – Schools can count exam duty, research projects, blogging, and online discussions towards CPD. Strict Compliance Warning– Schools failing to comply may face penalties as per CBSE Affiliation Bye-Laws.
