### THEME: GEN AI: THE NEW CLASSMATE

OXAMITE V4.0 organized by the OXANIUM CLUB under the aegis of IT department of Bal Bharati Public School, Noida is an Inter-School IT Based Competition. The theme of the fiesta is “Generative AI: The New Classmate”. It is an opportunity for students to achieve technological brilliance and showcase their talent in the field of emerging technology.

The event will be held in Online/Offline mode on 7<sup>th</sup> May, 2025 (Wednesday). The last date for registration and receipt of entries for the competition through Google forms is 23<sup>rd</sup> April, 2025. The event is powered by Adobe Express and hence all participating students will get a free access to the Adobe Express portal to create their submissions.

The date of submission for all online events is 03<sup>rd</sup> May, 2025. The list of finalists (Online Events) will be uploaded on our social media pages, event Whatsapp groups and our website by 04<sup>th</sup> May, 2025.

Entries submitted without registrations will not be entertained.

Participation of a student in multiple events is allowed, however in case of participation in overlapping events, it is the responsibility of the participant to manage the same.

#### PRELIMS:

- All the registered participants will fill the submission form for prelims latest by 03<sup>rd</sup> May, 2025.
- The project file and the source file also need to be provided along with the submission. If anybody fails to do so, their entry will not be considered.
- The judgements will be made as per the judgement criteria published for each event and the decision of the judges will be final and binding.

#### FINALS:

- The finalists will be asked to make a presentation of their entries in the online/offline mode. The presentation will take place as per the schedule in the school premises.
- Time limit allowed for each presentation will be as per the guidelines provided for each event in the event brochure.

**Class :** VIII

**Participant(s) :** 01

**Theme :** "Life as a Student with AI"

**Software(s) to be used :** Adobe Express – Generative AI/Poster

**Objective:** Participants will design and generate original memes using Generative AI tools (text-to-image or image editing) on the theme "Life as a student with AI". The meme should reflect wit, relatability, and awareness of how AI is influencing students' daily academic or personal lives.

### Rules for prelims:

- Participants are required to submit a meme on the given theme in jpeg file format.
- Participants need to submit their project in the form of a viewable link along with the jpeg file.
- No pre-made or downloaded memes are allowed
- Plagiarism will lead to disqualification
- No inappropriate language, hate, violence, or political/religious content.
- Memes must be school-appropriate and adhere to respectful humor.
- The submission of the original meme along with the exact AI prompt used to generate the image is to be done latest by 03<sup>rd</sup> May, 2025 using the google form link provided on page 06.

### Rules for finals:

- Results of the prelims will be declared on the Event Whatsapp groups latest by 04 May 2025. The shortlisted entries will be posted on our Instagram handle for likes. The entry with the maximum number of likes will be eligible for +5 grace points.
- Shortlisted participants are required to present their final meme during the online meeting on 07 May 2025.

**Software:** Adobe Express

**Objective:** To encourage students to think critically and creatively about global challenges - **climate change, waste management, and mental health in schools** and design AI-based solutions using technology, innovation, and empathy. The shortlisted students will pitch their solutions to the judges.

## Rules for Prelims:

- Participants will brainstorm an AI-based solution to their chosen problem and submit a one-page idea proposal infographic and 01-minute video explaining:
  - The real-world problem
  - How AI will be used
  - Tools/technologies involved
  - Expected impact
- The proposal must be original and designed by the team.
- Any kind of plagiarism will result in instant disqualification.
- Participants need to submit the pdf file and the published link of the infographic in the submission form provided on page 06.
- Jury has all the rights reserved. In case of any conflict, decision of the Jury shall be final and binding.

**Team:** 01

**Participant(s) :** 02

**Theme :** "Voices of the Future: AI for a Better Tomorrow"

**Software(s) to be used :** Adobe Express – Generative AI/Animate with Voice

**Language:** English or Hindi (or bilingual, with clear transitions).

**Objective:** Participants must focus on how AI is transforming various sectors—education, healthcare, environment, ethics, creativity, etc. and create a podcast 2 – 3 mins long using Adobe Express only.

### Rules for prelims:

- Participants are required to submit their podcast on the given theme in mp3/mp4 file format.
- Participants need to submit their project in the form of a viewable link along with the jpeg file.
- Podcasts must align with the theme and should maintain a positive and informative tone.
- Background music, sound effects, and voice modulation can be used but must not overpower the narration.
- No offensive, sensitive, or plagiarized content will be accepted.
- No inappropriate language, hate, violence, or political/religious content.
- The submission of the original podcast to be done latest by 03<sup>rd</sup> May, 2025 using the google form link provided on page 06.

### Rules for finals:

- Results of the prelims will be declared on the Event Whatsapp groups latest by 04 May 2025.
- Shortlisted participants are required to present and describe the final podcast's concept in 100 - 150 words during the online meeting on 07 May 2025.
