# MANDATORY 50 HOURS OF CONTINUOUS PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT (CPD) – 2025-26

A pivotal aspect of educational excellence is Continuous Professional Development (CPD). In alignment with the transformative vision of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 and the National Professional Standards for Teachers (NPST), the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has issued updated and comprehensive guidelines for CPD. Following the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 and CBSE guidelines, all teachers must complete 50 hours of Continuous Professional Development (CPD) annually. This initiative aims to enhance professional skills, keep educators updated with modern teaching methodologies, and maintain high educational standards.

#### Out of the 50 hours, training is categorized as follows:

- 25 Hours by CBSE (As per Notification 16/2021)
- 25 Hours by School (As per Notification 16/2021)

To facilitate the submission and tracking of training details, a Google Form has been developed and will be published shortly. Upon submission, the associated Google Sheet will be automatically populated, displaying training hours with a clear colour-coded system: 0-24 hours will appear in **Red**, 25-49 hours in **Yellow**, and over 49 hours in **Green**. Furthermore, a Google Drive link containing individual folders for each teacher will be shared soon and all teachers are requested to update their respective folders with relevant training details.

The 50 hours of Continuous Professional Development (CPD) has to be completed in the following three domains with the hours and topics specified against each domain.
