Bharat Mandapam at Pragati Maidan, New Delhi, houses the Anubhuti Kendra, an experiential center dedicated to the Prime Minister's PM Gati Shakti initiative and the One District One Product (ODOP) program. Launched in October 2021, PM Gati Shakti integrates planning across 16 ministries to enhance infrastructure connectivity and reduce logistics costs. The Anubhuti Kendra leverages cutting-edge audio-visual technology to narrate India's infrastructure development story, blending state-of-the-art engineering with traditional culture.

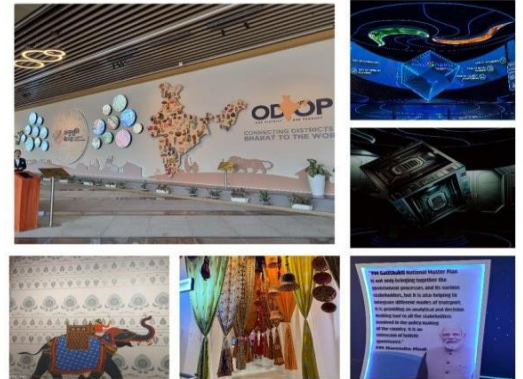


OVERVIEW OF ANUBHUTI KENDRA

Anubhuti Kendra serves as a modern museum for India's infrastructure journey. The visitor experience begins with a virtual helicopter ride showcasing interconnections among roads, railways, and utilities. The center features 270° projection theatres, holographic displays, augmented-reality kiosks, and touchscreens that explore project timelines and data layers. Traditional artisans from ODOP districts are highlighted, weaving India's cultural and developmental stories together.

Visitor Experience

Visitors embark on a 40-minute guided tour beginning with a VR helicopter simulation over national projects. They experience a cinematic journey in a 270° surround-screen auditorium, followed by hands-on exhibits of ODOP products and touch-based interactive kiosks. Cultural performances and real-time craft demonstrations add depth to the experience. The center effectively blends education, interaction, and inspiration, leaving visitors with a deeper understanding of India's unified planning vision.

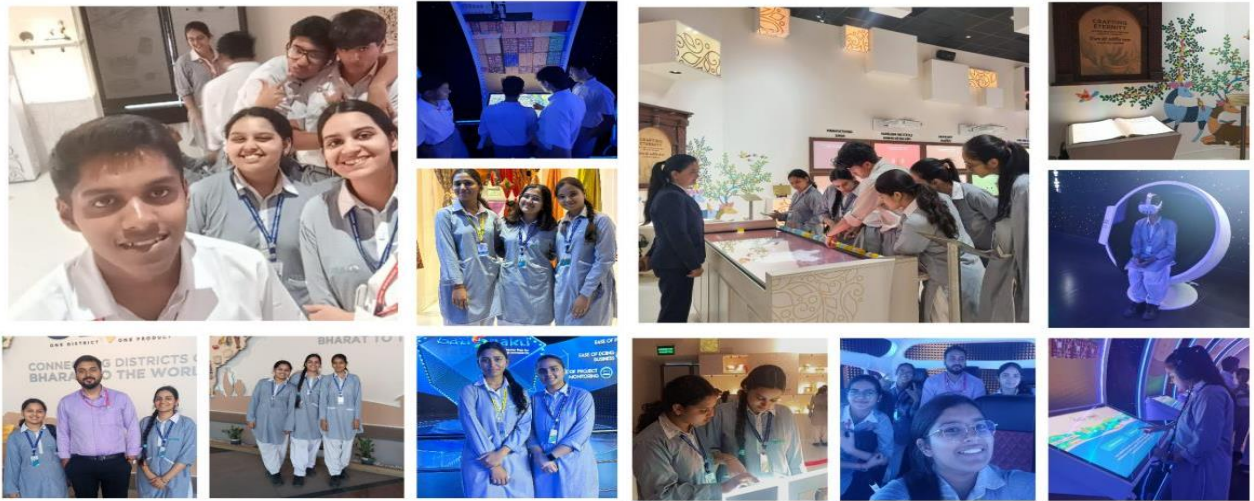
