

REPORT ON CBSE HEALTHCARE TRAINING PROGRAM AT ACCORD HOSPITAL, FARIDABAD

This skill-based program, aligned with the **Credit Framework** and conducted entirely by senior **doctors and medical professionals**, aimed to enhance our practical knowledge and readiness for careers in healthcare. The training included extensive sessions in the **Composite Skill Lab (CSL)**, mental health, interactive discussions, and real-time demonstrations with the aim of bridging classroom learning with real-world medical practices. This skill course can be opted by **students of all streams** & makes them eligible for joining different job profiles in the hospital.



Topics Covered During the Training:

The curriculum was intensive and well-structured, covering a broad spectrum of advanced healthcare topics, including:

- First Aid & Emergency Response
- Hyperthermia: Causes, Management, and Prevention
- Food-Borne Illnesses: Identification and Safety Measures
- Care of the Body After Death: Ethical and procedural aspects
- Disaster Preparedness & Emergency Response Protocols
- **TRIAGE**: Prioritization of patient care during mass casualties in to Red, Yellow Green & Black.
- Patient Flow in IPD and OPD: Administrative and clinical processes
- Surgeries: Pre-operative and post-operative care overview
- TPA (Third Party Administrators): Insurance-related hospital processes
- Chronological Medical Documentation: Professional medical recordkeeping
- Organ Donation: Ethical, legal, and procedural framework
- Dialysis & Renal Care
- Laboratory Work & Diagnostics
- In-Vitro Fertilization (IVF): An introduction to reproductive technology





Following the training sessions, participants were taken on a **guided tour of the hospital**, to visit departments such as Emergency, ICU, Dialysis, and the IVF Centre.

Visit in each department included detailed explanations and **case study discussions**, helping us understand clinical decision-making, patient management, and inter-departmental coordination in realtime hospital settings. These were also linked to classroom learning with actual clinical practices

It was also conveyed by Ms Pooja Akshay Under Secretary CBSE that Health Care (813) is a Super Advanced Skill subject with a weightage of Total Marks: 100 – Theory: 60, Practical: 40, students after class XII will be eligible for employment in hospitals with competitive salaries.

- Bharat Sevak Samaj (BSS), A National Development Agency, Promoted by Government of India provides one-year certification and two-year diploma courses, in Operation Theatre Technology, EEG & EMG , Dialysis, Medical Transcription Etc delivered through Theory & hands-on training in super-specialty hospitals. These programs provide opportunities for deeper specialization and structured skill development in key healthcare domains.

This experience has broadened my perspective on healthcare and reaffirmed my aspiration to serve in this noble profession with compassion, competence, and commitment.
